

# PASTOR'S NOTE

#### December 3rd ~ First Sunday of Advent

Jesus sets the tone for how we are to approach this Advent with these words in today's Gospel, "Be watchful! Be alert! You do not know when the time will come." The Church gives us Advent as the season of waiting and preparing for the coming of Christ at the end of time. Yet preparations for Christmas occupy our time leaving little or no time for reflection on Christ's admonition. This Advent, let us strive to make it a daily practice to take ten minutes each day to turn our attention to Jesus and to his presence. What change can we make or what practice can we adopt in our daily lives that will help ready us for the time when Christ comes to take us home?

Dear parishioners,

As we begin a new Church year with the First Sunday of Advent of year B, I wish you a Happy New Year! I pray that the new liturgical year we have embarked on be for each one of you a year of grace, peace, commitment, and gratitude to God. The season of Advent prepares us to receive Christ at Christmas with renewed hearts and minds. Let the call to prepare the way for the Lord resound in our minds and hearts and help us be better Christians.

I am also pleased to report that, for the past 2 weeks, our parish has seen a considerable increase in weekend collection/offertory; this is a sign that our Grateful Discipleship program has started bearing fruit thanks to all of you who have increased your weekend collection. Kindly refer to the bulletin to see the progress we are making. Our goal has been to have 100 people/families return their commitment forms indicating the parish ministries you want to be part of and the increased amount you will henceforth be donating to the Church. So far, thirty-seven people returned their forms, that is, 37% of our goal. With the progress we are making, you can imagine how far we will get if we were close to our goal. Once again, I urge anyone who hasn't made their commitment yet to do so for the good of our parish and as a sign of our gratitude to God from whom everything we have comes. The Grateful Discipleship committee is compiling the commitment forms and everyone who has returned theirs should expect to be contacted by the leaders of the ministries they want to embrace.

On another note, the financial report for last year as well as the budget for the current year have been inserted in last week's bulletin. They are also made available online in case you did not have the chance of picking up a copy of the bulletin.

I am so grateful to each and every one of you for being part of Ste. Anne Parish and for the gift of your time, talent and treasure.

I wish you all a fruitful and happy Advent season in preparation for Christmas.



#### SIMBANG GABI 2023: A Revered Filipino Christmas Tradition

Simbang Gabi, which means "Night Mass or Evening Mass," is a novena, a devotional 9-day series of Masses attended by Filipino Catholics in anticipation

of Christmas and to honor the Blessed Mother. The 9 Masses represent the 9month stay of the Infant Jesus in the womb of our Lady leading up to Christmas, and so, we join or accompany her, so to speak, as she awaits the birth of her Son. This is the second year that Simbang Gabi will be celebrated in Ste. Anne's church. Simbang Gabi is an occasion to evangelize and deepen one's faith, build our communities, celebrate



fellowship among other communities of different cultures, pray together, reach out to friends, re-live and share memories, impart to our young our culture and religious heritage, and above all, be ultimately blessed by our God. Please join us on December 15th-23rd. The Masses will start at 7PM. We will be praying the Rosary beginning at 6:30PM followed by a few prelude songs. A simple food sharing will be right after the Mass every night as part of the tradition. On the 23rd, there will be a potluck celebration in the Parish Center with some Christmas carol songs and celebration. Everyone is welcome! #### Society of St Vincent de Paul ~ Salem


