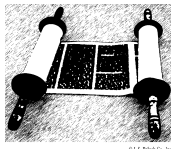


Our Gospel today continues Jesus' Sermon on the Plain, in which we heard Luke's version of the Beatitudes. This week, Jesus gives us new "commandments," telling us how to live and act in the world as his disciples, rooted in the radical love of God for humanity. It reminds us of his later speech about loving one another as he loves us, in other words with a God-like love, the kind we see in today's psalm about God's mercy. How else could we do as Jesus tells us by loving our enemies, which seems impossible, until we remember that God gave us the example of Jesus, who is like God but also like us? David understands this merciful love when he spares the life of his enemy in the first reading. Finally, Paul tells us that we will become like Jesus if we act as he did, as God does.

Saint of the day: Saint Eucherius of Orleans was also known as Eucher. She was born to the nobility, Eucherius was a very pious in youth, and

highly educated; legend says that his pregnant mother had a dream of an angel who told her that her unborn son would be a holy bishop, and blessed them both.

He took the cowl in Jumièges, Normandy, France in 714. When his uncle

Suaveric, bishop of Orleans, France, died, the clergy and faithful asked for Eucherius as his replacement. Eucherius fought the appointment, but finally agreed.

He was an active, evangelizing bishop who often visited the monasteries in his diocese. When Charles Martel confiscated Church property to finance his war against the Saracens, Eucherius protested. After his victory, Martel exiled the reluctant bishop to Cologne, Germany. There he was greeted enthusiastically, even receiving the position of distributor of the governor's alms. He was then exiled to Hesbaye in modern Belgium where he retired to the monastery of Sint-Truiden. Saint Eucherius of Orleans died on 20 February 743 at the monastery of Sint-Truiden in Belgium of natural causes. His relics enshrined on 11 August 880 and later re-enshrined on 11 August 1169

DESTRUYAN A SUS ENEMIGOS

RECIPROCIDAD
