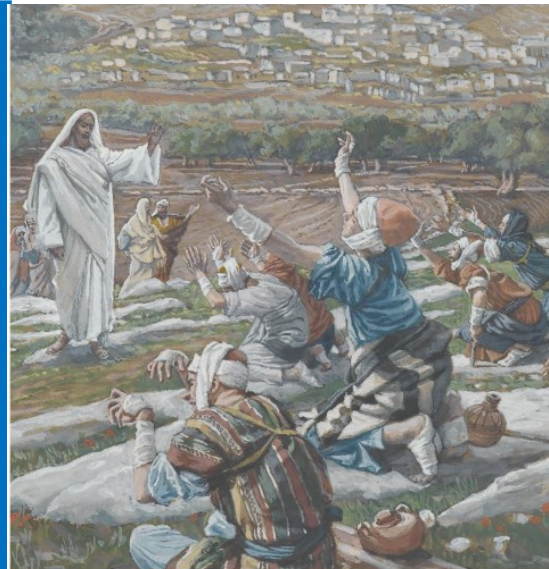

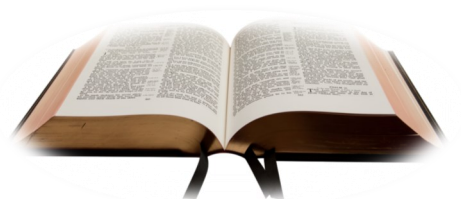

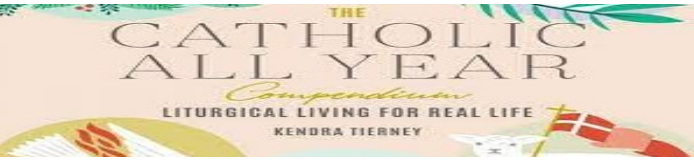

"Simply lighting a candle at mealtime and singing or saying our thanks to God attracts and delights even the youngest child. The baptismal sign of belonging to Christ — a small cross traced with your thumb on the child's forehead — can become a nightly blessing. Of course, mealtime and bedtime are not the only times of prayer. Little children love to "be with God" frequently. We can offer them a special prayer corner by preparing a low table or shelf, or even a deep windowsill, with a cloth perhaps the color of the liturgical season, a crucifix of the risen Christ, a statue of the Good Shepherd or the Madonna and Child, and a vigil light or a small vase with a flower from the garden. Simplicity is the best guideline for fostering prayer."~cgsusa.org

"Simplemente encender una vela a la hora de comer y cantar o dar gracias a Dios atrae y deleita incluso al niño más pequeño. La señal bautismal de pertenecer a Cristo, una pequeña cruz trazada con el pulgar en la frente del niño, puede convertirse en una bendición nocturna. Podemos ofrecerles un rincón especial de oración preparando una mesa o estante bajo, o incluso un alféizar profundo de la ventana, con un paño quizás del color de la temporada litúrgica, un crucifijo de Cristo resucitado, una estatua del Buen Pastor o de la Virgen con el Niño, y una luz de vigilia o un pequeño jarrón con una flor del jardín. La simplicidad es la mejor guía para fomentar la oración".
