

The Holy Family Catholic Education Scholarship

Sponsored by The Tim and Karen Michel Charitable Fund

The Holy Family Catholic Education Scholarship has been created to assist an eligible family in providing a Catholic education to their children.

The sponsors of the scholarship believe that developing the whole student is of extreme importance and that, along with the family, Holy Family School plays an essential role in the process. They also understand that choosing a Catholic education comes with increased financial obligations and that some families may find it difficult to meet these costs.

Among other attributes, a Catholic education serves to:

- Provide a sound foundation in our faith
- Teach respect of self and others
- Provide a high-level of academic excellence
- Produce students with sound moral values
- Reinforce and support the family in the development of a productive person

The scholarship amount is equal to one year's tuition at Holy Family School (Pays the subsidized parish rate for a first child in Grades 1 through 8 **Not to exceed \$5,000**). Key considerations in awarding the scholarship include:

- **Need** – This is the primary consideration as it is intended that the scholarship assist a family who may otherwise find the financial obligation of attending Holy Family School a significant and, perhaps, prohibitive burden.
- **Grades** – The students must demonstrate they are putting forth a strong effort to do well in school.
- **Parish and school or community involvement** – The student and family needs to be engaged in the Catholic faith, attending Mass regularly, and participating in school activities, and/or the community.
- **Other considerations**– Student participation in other activities, such as scouts and sports.

Awarding of the scholarship will be determined by the school's normal process for granting assistance and scholarships (ex. the scholarship committee). The sponsors will be notified of the recipient and their circumstances, without disclosing the family name, in order to ensure it is being awarded according to their intentions.
