

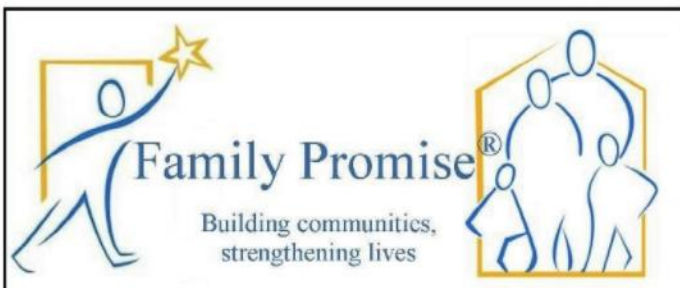

## Family Promise News

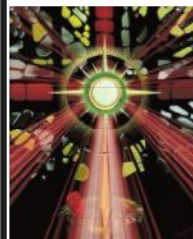

The Franciscan Monastery of the Holy Land in America is the home of a world-wide Commissariat of Friars Minor and monasteries who function as bridges between the Holy Land and Christians all over the world. The Franciscans of the Custody of the Holy Land have the unique responsibility of caring for the Holy Places as well as caring for the Christians living in the Holy Land. It is vital that we care for the Christians living in the Holy Land in order to maintain a Christian presence in a land that is filled with a majority Islamic and Jewish population.

Holy Land Franciscans staff and maintain the Holy places and shrines. This enables those who live in the Holy Land, and those who visit, to deepen their faith and their spiritual and cultural connection to Salvation history.


