St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) is well known as the nun whose revelations helped popularize devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Without denying the devotion's scriptural, patristic, and medieval foundations, we can safely say that the devotion to the Sacred Heart's modern western form sprang primarily from St. Margaret Mary's visions.

The Twelve Promises of Jesus to Saint Margaret Mary for those devoted to His Sacred Heart:

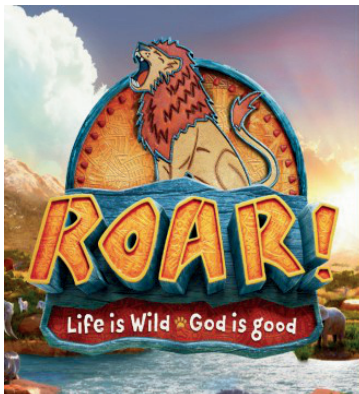
1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
2. I will establish peace in their families.
3. I will console them in all their troubles.
4. They shall find in My Heart an assured refuge during life and especially at the hour of their death.
5. I will pour abundant blessings on all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source of an infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection.
9. I will bless the homes where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored.
10. I will give to priests the power of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced.
12. The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under my displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments; My heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.

"Look at this Heart which has loved men so much, and yet men do not want to love Me in return. Through you My Divine Heart wishes to spread its love everywhere on earth."

En sus revelaciones a Santa Margarita María de Alacoque, Jesucristo le dio a conocer 12 promesas para los devotos de su Sagrado Corazón. "Al Corazón de Jesús le agradan mucho los servicios de los pequeños y humildes de corazón, y paga con bendiciones sus trabajos", decía la santa. Puede conocer más sobre su vida.

4. Seré su amparo y refugio seguro durante la vida, y principalmente en la hora de la muerte.
5. Derramaré bendiciones abundantes sobre sus empresas.
6. Los pecadores hallarán en mi Corazón la fuente y el océano infinito de la misericordia.
7. Las almas tibias se harán fervorosas.
8. Las almas fervorosas se elevarán rápidamente a gran perfección.
9. Bendeciré las casas en que la imagen de mi Sagrado Corazón esté expuesta y sea honrada.
10. Daré a los sacerdotes la gracia de mover los corazones empedernidos.
11. Las personas que propaguen esta devoción, tendrán escrito su nombre en mi Corazón y jamás será borrado de él.
12. A todos los que comulguen nueve primeros viernes de mes continuos, el amor omnipotente de mi Corazón les concederá la gracia de la perseverancia final.

Feast Day August 24

Born 1st Century AD in Israel in Asia,
One of the Twelve Apostles of Jesus
Worked in Galilee, India and Armenia,
died 1st Century AD in Albanopolis, Armenia
Beatification By Pre-Congregation
Canonization By Pre-Congregation

Saint Bartholomew was one of the twelve who were called to the apostolate by our blessed Lord Himself.

Several learned interpreters of the Holy Scripture take this apostle to have been the same as Nathaniel, a native of Cana, in Galilee, a doctor in the Jewish law, and one of the seventy-two disciples of Christ, to whom he was conducted by St. Philip, and whose innocence and simplicity of heart deserved to be celebrated with the highest eulogium by the divine mouth of Our Redeemer. He is mentioned among the disciples who were met together in prayer after Christ's ascension, and he received the Holy Ghost with the rest. Being eminently qualified by the divine grace to discharge the functions of an apostle, he carried the Gospel through the most barbarous countries of the East, penetrating into the remoter Indies.

He then returned again into the northwest part of Asia, and met St. Philip, at Hierapolis, in Phrygia. Hence, he traveled into Lycaonia, where he instructed the people in the Christian Faith; but we know not even the names of many of the countries in which he preached. St. Bartholomew's last removal was into Great Armenia, where, preaching in a place obstinately addicted to the worship of idols, he was crowned with a glorious martyrdom. The modern Greek historians say that he was condemned by the governor of Albanopolis to be crucified. Others affirm that he was flayed alive, which might well enough consist with his crucifixion, this double punishment being in use not only in Egypt, but also among the Persians.

The characteristic virtue of the apostles was zeal for the divine glory, the first property of the love of God. A soldier is always ready to defend the honor of his prince, and a son that of his father; and can a Christian say he loves God who is indifferent to His honor?
