Everything you need to know about Coronavirus (COVID-19)



The novel coronavirus, also known as COVID-19, is a respiratory disease that was first detected in China. It has now been detected in many countries, including in the United States.

Symptoms

Symptoms include fever, cough, and shortness of breath and may appear 2 to 14 days after exposure.

Severity

Worldwide illnesses have ranged from mild to severe, including illness resulting in death. Older people and people with underlying health conditions seem to be at greater risk of serious illness. Those conditions include heart disease, lung disease, and cancer.

How it spreads

The virus is thought to spread between people in close contact (within 6 feet) and through droplets when an infected person coughs or sneezes.

Treatment

There are no medications specifically approved for COVID-19. People with coronavirus should be treated with supportive care to help relieve symptoms. Some severe cases require going to the hospital, particularly in the elderly or those who have underlying medical conditions.

What to do if you are sick

- 1** If you recently traveled to an area affected by COVID-19 transmission AND you feel sick, stay home and call your doctor immediately. Do not go to the doctor without calling first.
- 2** If you have a fever, cough, or shortness of breath, call your primary care provider.
- 3** If you do not have a primary care provider, call the Louisiana Department of Health hotline at 1-855-523-2652.
- 4** If you are severely ill and you think you need to go to the hospital, call 9-1-1 or go to an emergency room.

Prevent the spread of respiratory illness, including COVID-19.



Wash hands with soap and water often. Use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.



Stay home if you feel sick to prevent the spread of germs.



Cover your cough with your elbow to prevent the spread of germs.

El COVID-19 (nuevo coronavirus) es un virus que causa enfermedad respiratoria. Su situación es una muy dinámica y bajo evolución. Actualmente, es una seria amenaza a la salud pública. El virus se encuentra propagándose a nivel mundial con casos reportados en los Estados Unidos y Puerto Rico. Las estrategias generales provistas por los Centros para el Control y Prevención de Enfermedades (CDC) que recomiendan para evitar la propagación del COVID-19 en las organizaciones comunitarias de fe, son las mismas acciones preventivas que con otros virus respiratorios como la influenza.

Sin embargo, todos somos susceptibles a este virus que por primera vez circula en nuestras comunidades y tenemos la capacidad de transmitirle a otros aún cuando presentemos sintomatología leve. Se han identificado grupo poblacionales que tienen mayor probabilidad de complicaciones, incluyendo adultos mayores (60 años o más) o con algunas condiciones crónicas (hipertensión, diabetes, enfermedad respiratoria, entre otras). Para proteger nuestras comunidades, todos debemos promover acciones saludables.

A nivel individual, no debemos saludarnos físicamente sino simbólicamente y con reverencia, por ejemplo con el saludo japonés; nos toca el lavado frecuente de manos con agua y jabón por 20 segundos, evitar conglomerados de personas, buena higiene respiratoria (al toser o estornudar cubrir con el codo u hombro). Esta situación requiere tomar acciones preventivas en distintos niveles. La Iglesia ya ha adoptado recomendaciones similares en otras diócesis del mundo.

Recordamos a todos los cristianos y cristianas que la Cuaresma es un tiempo oportuno para intensificar la oración. Pedimos al Señor, por la intercesión de Nuestra Señora Madre de la Divina Providencia, que de consuelo al que sufre, termine con esta pandemia, e infunda en todos nosotros y nosotras el bálsamo de su amor, paz y misericordia para que seamos librados de lo peor de esta enfermedad.



Tips to Pray the Rosary Daily

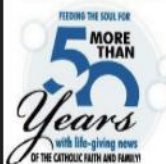


1. Carry a rosary in your pocket.

3. Recite the rosary while doing chores or while you work out.
4. Use images and music. The rosary is a contemplative prayer.
5. If you are upset, pray for the situation that worries you.
6. Pray while you walk and think of the people in your life.
7. Use each mystery to ask for a specific intention.
8. If you can't pray the whole Rosary at once, break it into parts.
9. Say it in moments of sadness or spiritual drought.
10. Fall asleep praying the Rosary.
