Renewed Reverence for Receiving Holy Communion:

1. Dress properly.
2. Wear a mask.
3. Keep 6 feet distance.
4. Make a reverent bow while the person ahead of you receives Holy Communion.
5. Step up and respond "Amen" to "The Body of Christ."
6. Step aside to remove your mask and consume the Holy Communion.
7. Return to your seating area.

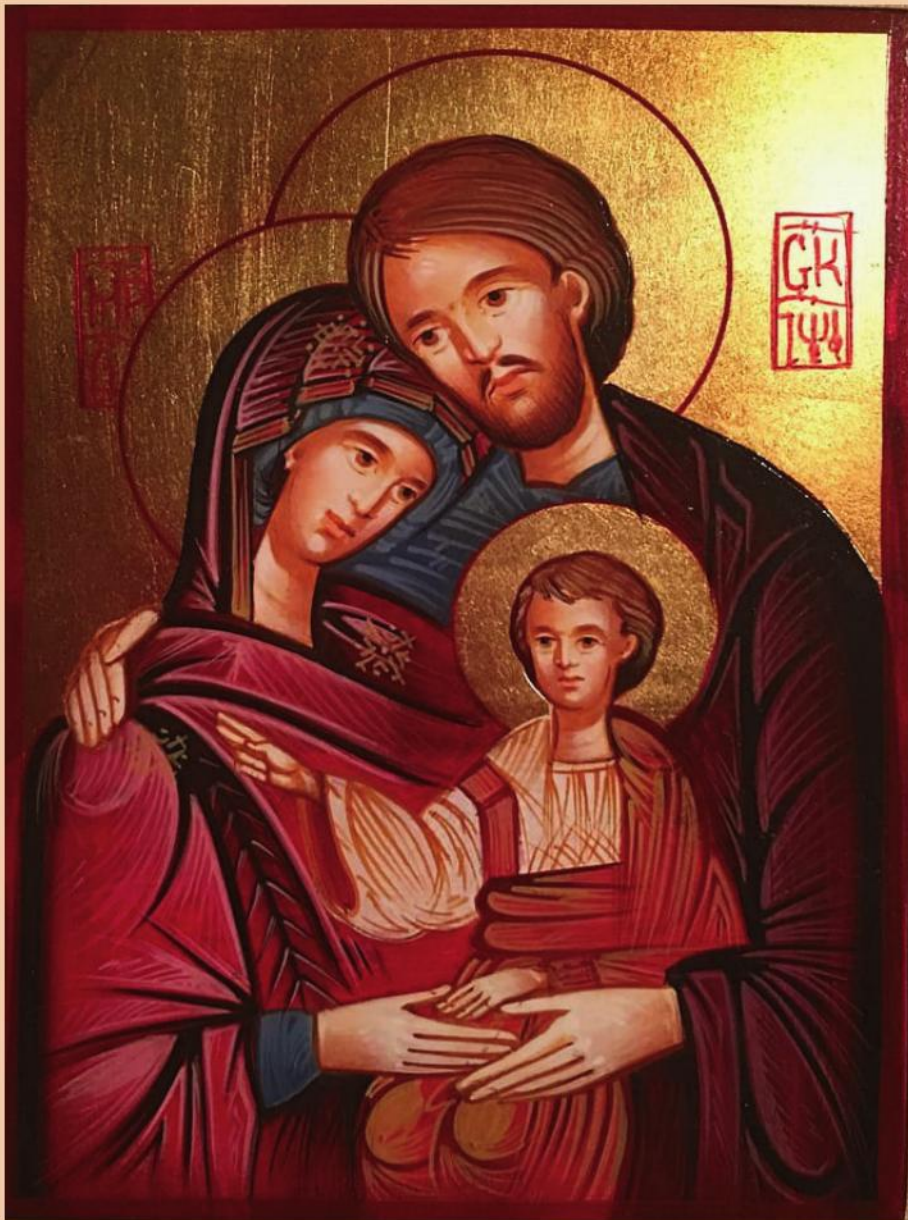

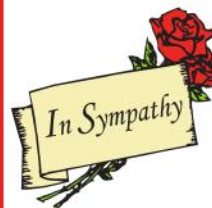

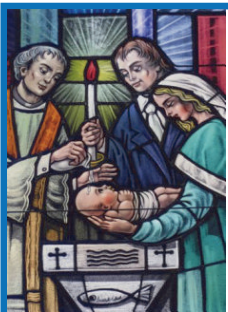
Life and Dignity (by Pope Francis)

What we are called to respect in each person is first of all his life, his physical integrity, his dignity and the rights deriving from that dignity, his reputation, his property, his ethnic and cultural identity, his ideas and his political choices. We are therefore called to think, speak and write respectfully of the other, not only in his presence, but always and everywhere, avoiding unfair criticism or defamation. Families, schools, religious teaching and all forms of media have a role to play in achieving this goal. (7/10/13)

A widespread mentality of the useful, the "culture of waste" that today enslaves the hearts and minds of so many, comes at a very high cost: it asks for the elimination of human beings, especially if they are physically or socially weaker. Our response to this mentality is a decisive and unreserved "yes" to life. "The first right of the human person is his life. He has other goods and some are more precious, but this one is fundamental — the condition of all the others" (Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, Declaration on procured abortion, 18 November 1974, n. 11). Things have a price and can be sold, but people have a dignity; they are worth more than things and are above price. So often we find ourselves in situations where we see that what is valued the least is life. That is why concern for human life in its totality has become in recent years a real priority for the Church's Magisterium, especially for the most defenseless; i.e., the disabled, the sick, the newborn, children, the elderly, those whose lives are most defenseless. (9/20/13)

Today capital punishment is unacceptable, however serious the condemned's crime may have been. It is an offence to the inviolability of life and to the dignity of the human person which contradicts God's plan for man and for society and his merciful justice, and it fails to conform to any just purpose of punishment. It does not render justice to the victims, but rather foments revenge. (3/20/15)

Among the victims of this throw-away culture, I would like to remember here in particular the elderly, so many of whom have been welcomed in this home; the elderly are the memory and the wisdom of peoples. Their longevity is not always seen as a gift of God, but at times as a difficult burden to bear, especially when their health is seriously compromised. This mindset does not do society any good, and it is our task to develop an "antidote" to this way of considering the elderly, or people with disabilities, almost as if they were lives no longer worth living. This is a sin, it is a grave social sin. (6/21/15, Sick)

Vida y dignidad

Lo que estamos llamados a respetar en cada persona es ante todo su vida, su integridad física, su dignidad y los derechos que de ella derivan, su reputación, su propiedad, su identidad étnica y cultural, sus ideas y sus decisiones políticas. Estamos por ello llamados a pensar, hablar y escribir del otro de modo respetuoso, no sólo en su presencia, sino siempre y en todo lugar, evitando críticas injustas o difamaciones. Para alcanzar este objetivo, las familias, las escuelas, la enseñanza religiosa y todo tipo de medios de comunicación social tienen un papel que desarrollar. (10 de julio de 2013)

Una difundida mentalidad de lo útil, la "cultura del descarte", que hoy esclaviza los corazones y las inteligencias de muchos, tiene un altísimo coste: requiere eliminar seres humanos, sobre todo si son física o socialmente más débiles. Nuestra respuesta a esta mentalidad es un "sí" decidido y sin titubeos a la vida. "El primer derecho de una persona humana es su vida. Ella tiene otros bienes y algunos de ellos son más preciosos; pero aquél es el bien fundamental, condición para todos los demás" (Congregación para la doctrina de la fe, Declaración sobre el aborto procurado, 18 de noviembre de 1974, 11). Las cosas tienen un precio y se pueden vender, pero las personas tienen una dignidad, valen más que las cosas y no tienen precio. Muchas veces nos hallamos en situaciones donde vemos que lo que cuesta menos es la vida. Por esto la atención a la vida humana en su totalidad se ha convertido en los últimos años en una auténtica prioridad del Magisterio de la Iglesia, particularmente a la más indefensa, o sea, al discapacitado, al enfermo, al que va a nacer, al niño, al anciano, que es la vida más indefensa. (20 de septiembre de 2013)

Hoy día la pena de muerte es inadmisibles, por cuanto grave haya sido el delito del condenado. Es una ofensa a la inviolabilidad de la vida y a la dignidad de la persona humana que contradice el designio de Dios sobre el hombre y la sociedad y su justicia misericordiosa, e impide cumplir con cualquier finalidad justa de las penas. No hace justicia a las víctimas, sino que fomenta la venganza. (20 de marzo de 2015)

Entre las víctimas de esta cultura del descarte quisiera ahora recordar, en particular, a los ancianos... a muchos de los cuales acogéis en esta casa; los ancianos que son la memoria y la sabiduría de los pueblos. Su longevidad no siempre se considera un don de Dios, sino a veces, un peso difícil de soportar, especialmente cuando la salud está muy comprometida. Esta mentalidad no hace bien a la sociedad, y nuestra tarea es desarrollar los "anticuerpos" contra esta forma de considerar a los ancianos o a las personas con discapacidad, casi como si fueran vidas que no merecen la pena vivirse. Esto es pecado, un pecado social grave. (21 de junio de 2015, Enfermos)
