## MASS ETIQUETTE

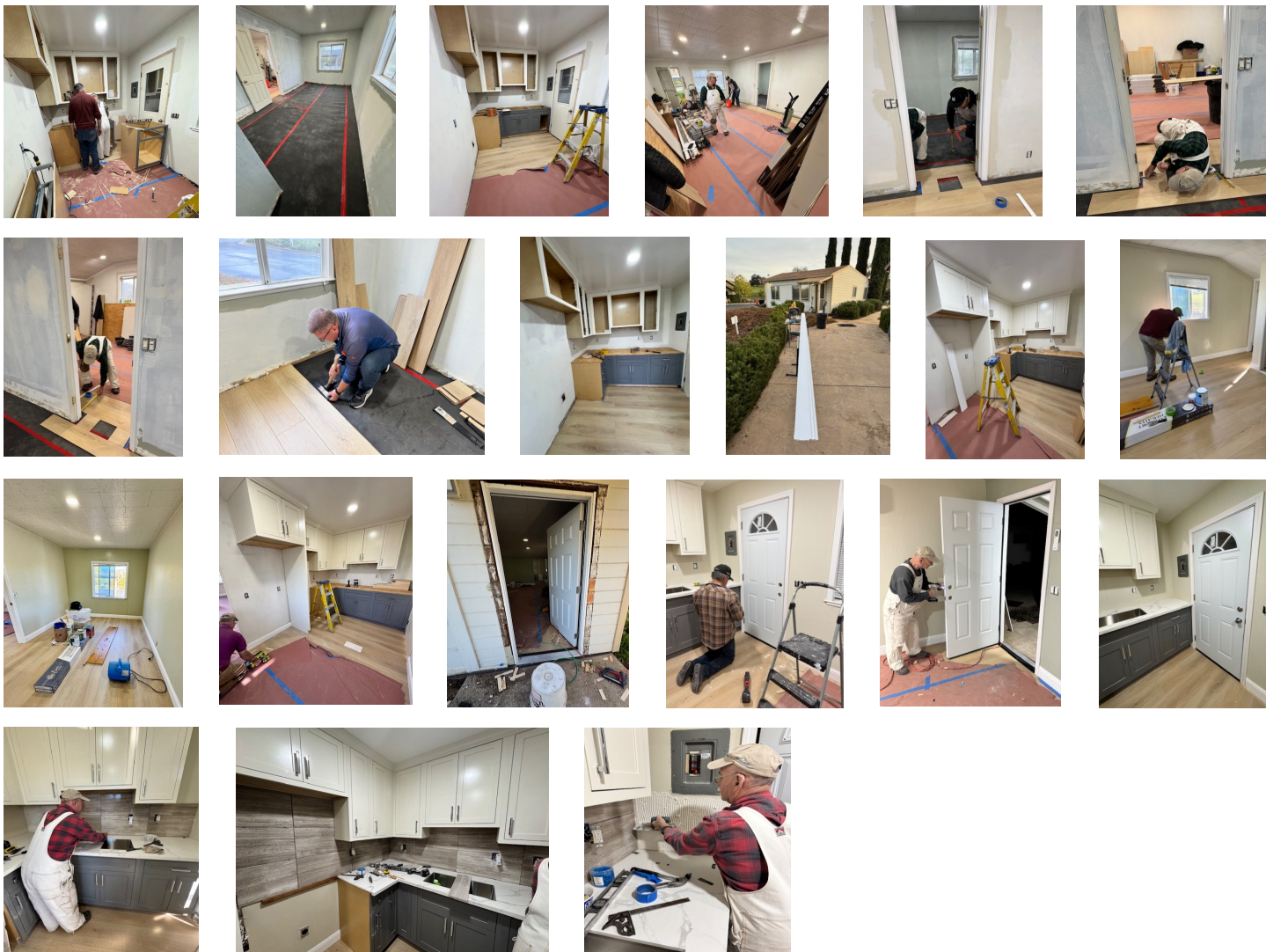
- Remember to **silence**, turn off, and put away your cell phones, tablets, and gaming devices prior the start of Mass.

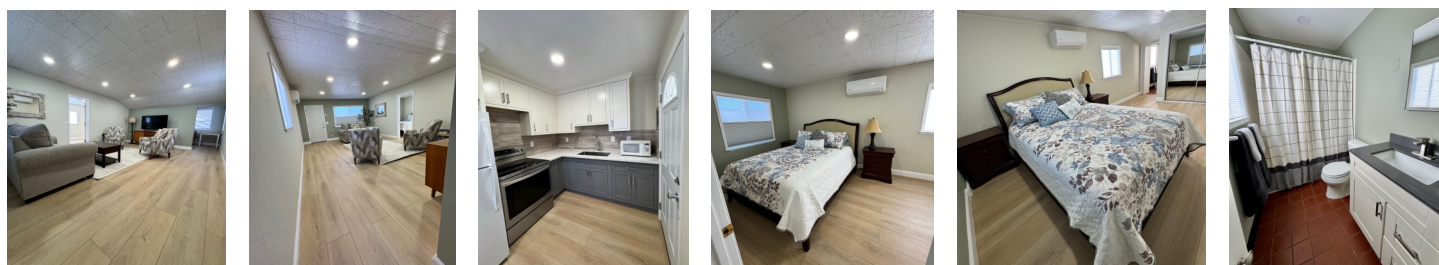
