

St. Thomas Aguinas (born in Sicily, Italy in 1224) was a Dominican philosopher and priest. He wrote many interesting and profound books to simplify Latin theology, and was also a great poet. He gave his theory about human personality, creation and Providence. When he was alive, there was a big demand to prove almost all concepts with very strict scientific ideas. His generation faced the changes of the growth of bigger cities, the reduction of the agricultural lands, and an increased sense of community. All of these, influenced his philosophy and books. He was an excellent teacher all throughout his life, and used a form of "questions" to present his pro and con arguments to encourage debates and deep thinking. He died at barely 50 years of age after getting ill during a trip to France.
