### FEAST OF ST. JAMES THE GREATER—JULY 25TH

Nothing is known of St. James the Greater's early life., though it has been established that he iss the son of Zebedee and Salome and brother of John the disciple. The title "the Greater" was added to St. James name to help distinguish him from the Apostle James "the less," who is believed to have been shorter than James "the Greater." Saint James the Greater was one of Jesus' first disciples. James was fishing with his father and John the Apostle when Jesus came to the shores of the Sea of Galilee and called for the fisherman who were unable to catch any fish that day to dip their nets in the water once again. When the fishermen followed Jesus instructions, they found their nets full, and after emptying the fisth on board, the boats nearly sank from weight. Following Christ's Ascension, James spread the Gospel across Israel and the Roman Kingdom as well. He traveled and spread the Word for nearly forty years in Spain. It is said that one day as he prayed, The Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to him and asked him to build her a church, which he did.
