GETTING TO KNOW MORE ABOUT OUR BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Church leaders said, “The birth of the Blessed Mother celebrates the dawning of the day of redemption”; the moment when the future mother of Christ, was born. In celebrating the Nativity of Mary, **Christians anticipate the Incarnation and birth of her Divine Son and give honor to the mother of our Lord.**

WHAT IS THE ROSARY?

The Rosary is a Scripture-based prayer that leads us to Jesus through Mary. The word rosary means garland of roses, which has been interpreted into the rosary of today, a string of beads. Mother Mary, also known as the Lady of the Rosary, urged everyone to pray the rosary **to help people grow in their faith, convert sinners, and bring about world peace.**

Begin the Rosary at the crucifix by praying the Apostles’ Creed. At each large bead pray the Lord’s Prayer. At each small bead pray the Hail Mary. At the first three beads pray a Hail Mary for each Gift of the Holy Spirit: faith, hope and love. For each Mystery begin with the Lord’s Prayer, recite the Hail Mary ten times, and end with the Glory be to the Father.
