



THE HISTORY OF DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The Octave or eighth day of Easter has always been considered special by Christians. Christ after His Resurrection, revealed Himself to the disciples but Saint Thomas wasn't with them. He declared that he would never believe that Christ had risen from the dead until he could see Him in the name Doubting Thomas. A week after Christ rose from the dead, He appeared once again to His disciples, and this stime Thomas was there. His doubt was vanquished, and he professed His belief in Christ. Nineteen centuries later, Christ appeared to a Polish nun, Sr. Maria Faustina Kowalska, in a series of visions that took place over almost eight years. Among those visions, Christ revealed the Divine Mercy Novena which He asked Sister Faustina to pray for nine days beginning on Good Friday. That meant that the novena ended on the Saturday after Easter, the eve of the Octave of Easter. Thus since novenas are commonly prayed in advance of a feast, the Feast of Divine Mercy—Divine Mercy Sunday was born.
