





On Ash Wednesday and all Fridays in Lent we are required to fast and abstain from eating meat. We are encouraged to keep a <u>Penitential spirit</u> all through Lent especially on Fridays. One of the ways we might do this is by not eating meat. In addition we can give up some treat or activity and we can decide to do something more for others.

### BEGINNING NEW PATTERNS DURING LENT

Something all of us can do is to commit ourselves on being more reflective during Lent. It just means that I'm going to make a point of being more observant, more aware of what is "automatic" behaviour. And, I then start paying attention to my desires. We have all kinds. During Lent, I can reflect upon the desires I currently have and which may need to be abandoned, and which are wonderful desires there but I haven't acted upon them. Naming our deepest desires will guide the churches we make to establish new patterns for Lent.
