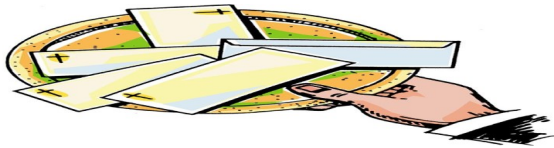

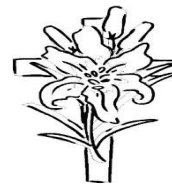
THOUGHTS ON THE ARISE PROGRAM
