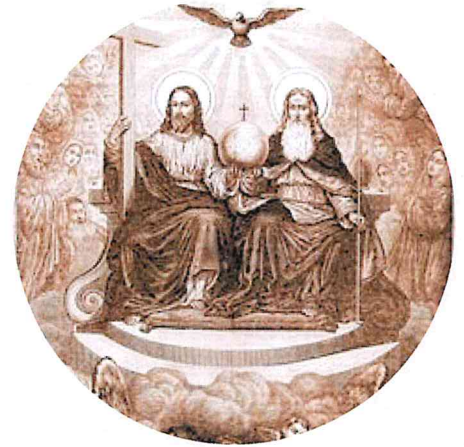

Tuesday, June 1st at 6pm: PC@Church; Join us at St. Pius for a Holy Hour to pray for vocations and the ordinations!

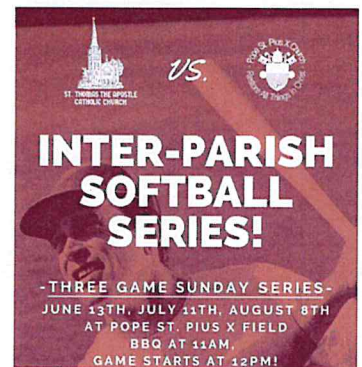
