

Matthew Loucks (Director of Sacred Music) began his musical career 1989 and has had the tremendous JOY to have founded/directed several Choral and "period instrument" ensembles including the Magnolia Chamber Orchestra, The Baroque Music Academy, the St. Mary Baroque Orchestra & Chamber Choir and the Blessed Sacrament Baroque Orchestra, Schola Cantorum and Sackbut Ensemble. Some "highlights" (thus far) have been directing the U.S. Premier of G.P. Telemann's Christmas Oratorio. J.S. Bach's Passion of St. John (on period instruments) as well as over 25 annual performances of G. F. Handel's MESSIAH.

Matthew has been a Director of Sacred Music for the Catholic Church since 1994 in both the Archdiocese of Denver and Seattle and has been blessed with the opportunity to be the Director of Sacred Music at Liturgies celebrated by Cardinal Arinze, Cardinal Stafford

and Archbishop Chaput. Mr. Loucks is a "champion" of "early" Sacred Music and makes it his mission in life to help faithful Catholics "pray the Mass" through the singing of ALL the various parts of the Mass Ordinary, the prescribed Antiphons/Psalms and a wealth of "sturdy" Hymns. Mr. Loucks also esteems our church's rich tradition of Sacred Polyphony (Motets and Mass Ordinaries) as well as solo works for the Pipe Organ.

Mr. Loucks holds music degrees in Music Theory/Literature and Composition and a Masters Degree in Conducting. Mr. Loucks was blessed to be the recipient of the "Outstanding Musicianship Award" and the "Academic Achievement Award" in musicology by the National Musical Honor Society for this "period performances of Sacred Music".

Matthew could not be more thrilled to be joining the faith community at St. Thomas the Apostle Parish and is grateful for the opportunity to serve and pray with such excellent and dedicated Music Minsters - building upon the "firm foundation" established by STA's preceding Musical Director and Music Ministers.

Matthew Johnson (Principal Organist) is 22 years old and originally from Issaquah, WA. Matthew began piano lessons at the age of five and, inspired by the beautiful sacred music of St. James Cathedral in Seattle, Matthew became interested in organ. He began his organ studies with Dr. Clint Kraus and later studied with Mr. Joseph Adam. His passion for organ crystallized while attending an organ camp at Interlochen Center for the Arts in Michigan when he was thirteen years old. Since then, Matthew has won numerous awards and scholarships including the Interlochen

Center for the Arts Fine Arts Award in Organ, Young Talent Award for the International Organ Festival in Haarlem, Netherlands, Philadelphia Young Artist Organ Institute, as well as medals in piano and organ at Musicfest Northwest in Spokane. His music endeavors have led him to study organ in France on a few occasions. Matthew was also honored to serve as the Organ Scholar at St. James Cathedral in Seattle and as a substitute organist at Blessed Sacrament in Seattle, where Matthew Loucks served as Director of Sacred Music.



Matthew Johnson will soon graduate with a degree in Organ Performance (Bachelor of Music) from McGill University in Montreal, Quebec where he studied with Professor Hans-Ola Ericsson, Dr. Jonathan Oldengarm, and Mr. Christian Lane. While in Montreal, Matthew held the Organ Scholar position at St. Andrew & St. Paul Presbyterian Church.

Matthew feels blessed to be able to use his talent to enrich the Sacred Liturgy at St. Thomas.
