ALMA REDEMPTORIS MATER

Our Marian Antiphon for the Advent and Christmas Season is the
Alma Redemptoris Mater.

This Sacred Hymn dates from the 11th Century and is thought to have been inspired by the writings of St. Irenaeus. It is the First of a sequence of Marian Antiphons sung seasonally which also include the *Ave Regina Caelorum*, *Regina Caeli* and the *Salve Regina*.

Each of these glorious Antiphons are available on the Sacred Music Website to assist in learning of these "timeless" Hymns that honoring the Blessed Virgin Mary.

The *Alma Redemptoris Mater* is sung from the First Sunday of Advent to Candlemas on February 2nd.
