

Sacred Music Ministry

THE LENTEN SEASON

"During Lent, it is not permitted to decorate the altar with flowers, and the use of musical instruments is allowed only to support the singing. Nevertheless, *Laetare* Sunday, Solemnities and Feasts are exceptions to this rule." (The Roman Missal)

For the Season of Lent, we enter a "musical fast" of sorts. The pipe organ and other instruments are present only to support the singing of the congregation and choir. For the duration of

the Season, there are to be no Organ prelude or postlude works.

The Gloria and the Gospel Acclamation (Alleluia) are also omitted for the entire season of Lent but will gloriously return in time for the Easter Vigil and the Easter Season!

Laetare Sunday (fourth Sunday of Lent) as well as the Solemnities of St. Joseph and the Annunciation are exempt from these observances given their "celebratory" nature.






