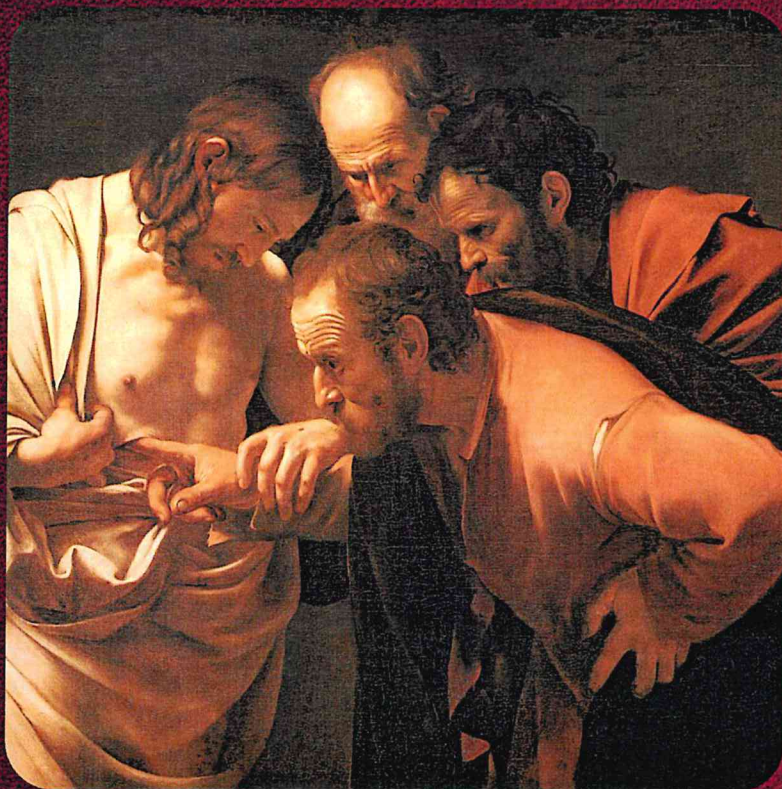

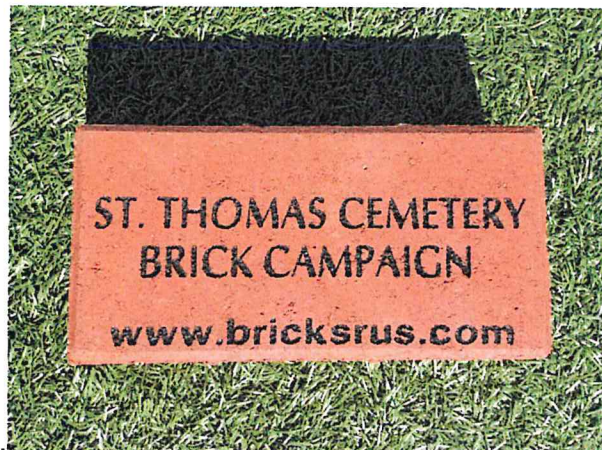
St Thomas Cemetery 2022 Paver Project
