We are called by name.

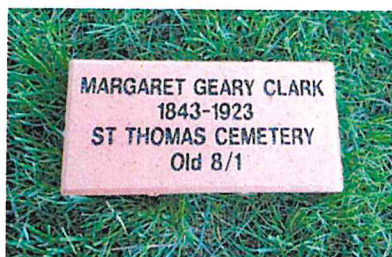
Did you know we have 274 unmarked graves in St Thomas Cemetery? Many of these unmarked graves are from the 1800's, with no one left who knows them.

All of us has a name.

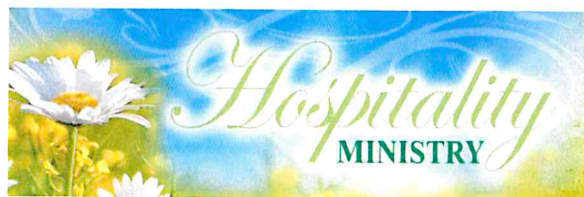
Please help us give a name to all the souls in our Historic Cemetery.
