contiguous property for our historic cemetery.*

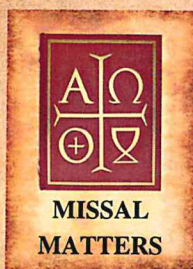

WHAT IS THE ROMAN MISSAL?

The Roman Missal is the official Liturgical Book of the Roman Catholic Church! Comparatively speaking: if we were a Football Team, it would be our Official Playbook! If we were a Chef: it would be our Official Cookbook! If we were a Builder: it would be our Official Blueprints!

The Roman Missal includes an extended "General Instruction" which provides specific and detailed information on how the Sacred Liturgy is to be celebrated (from start to finish) for the entire Liturgical Year including Sundays, Weekdays, Feast Days, Solemnities, Baptisms, Confirmations, etc...Funerals and Weddings as well!

These "General Instructions" contained in the Roman Missal are meant to ensure a Universal Celebration of the Sacred Liturgy for ALL Roman Catholics: locally, regionally, nationally...world-wide! (The word "Catholic" comes from the Greek word Katolikos which means: Universal).

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT THE CELEBRATION OF THE LITURGY TO BE UNIVERSAL?

Please continue to read future Bulletins for our new ongoing dialogue on the Roman Missal entitled "MISSAL MATTERS". Our objective is to inspire in our Parishioners perhaps a better understanding and appreciation for the glorious gift that is the Sacred Liturgy. Stay tuned!
