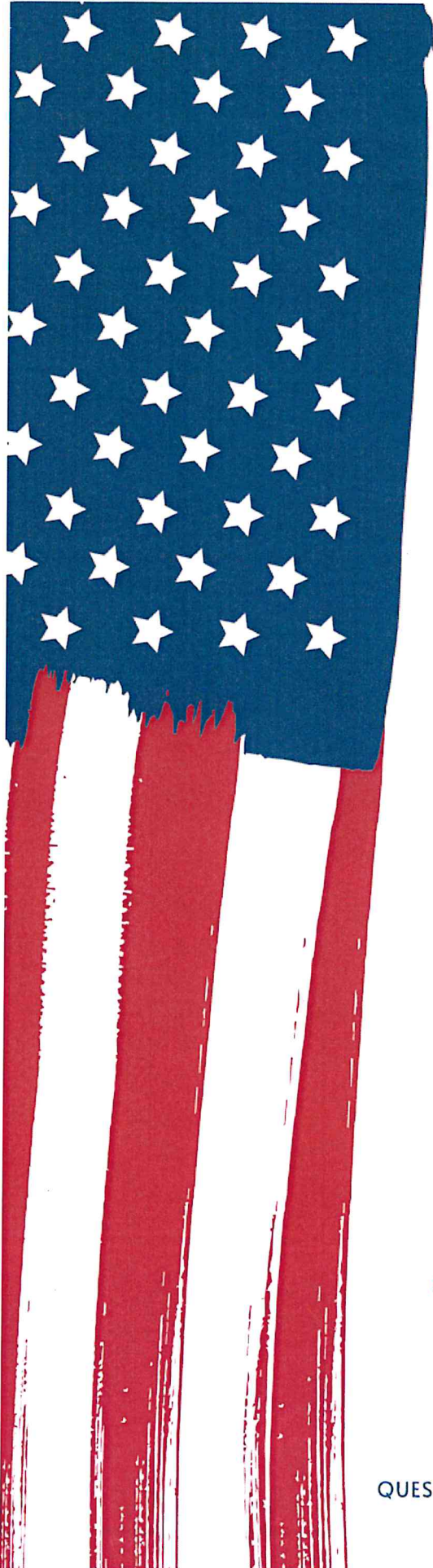

Mass at the Parish Center.



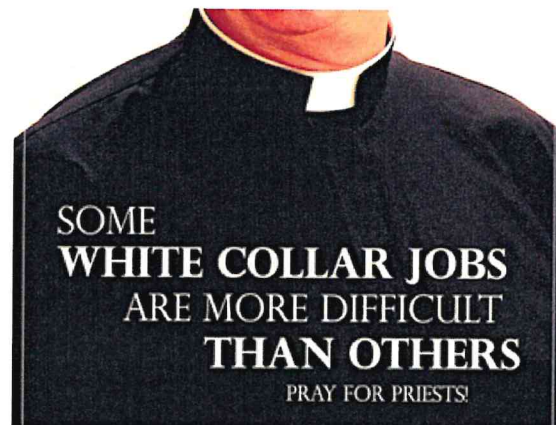

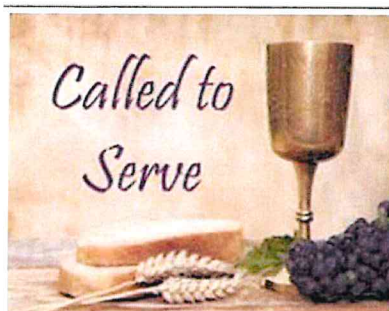
