### Saint's Reflection

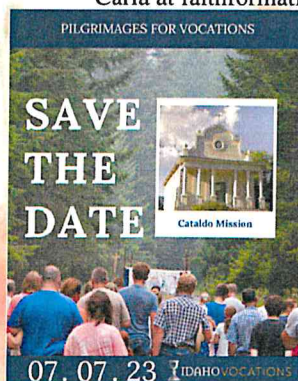

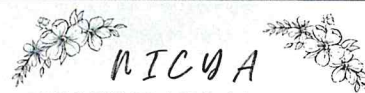

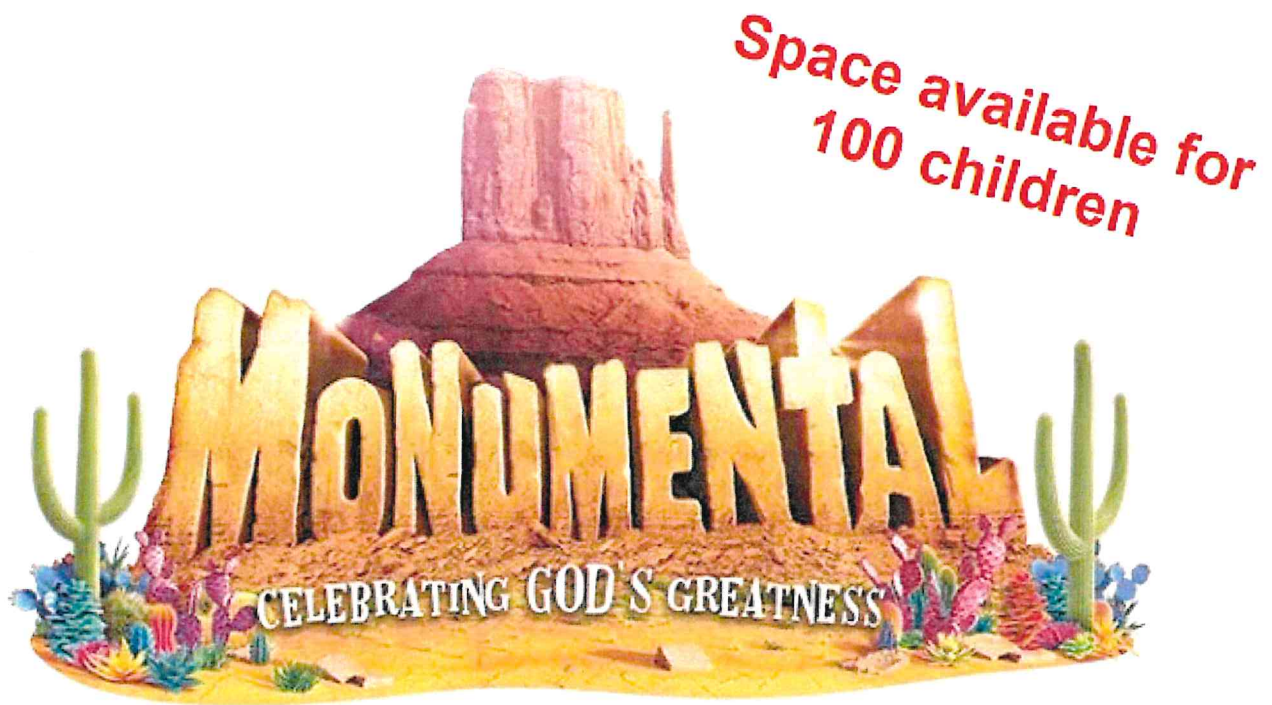
