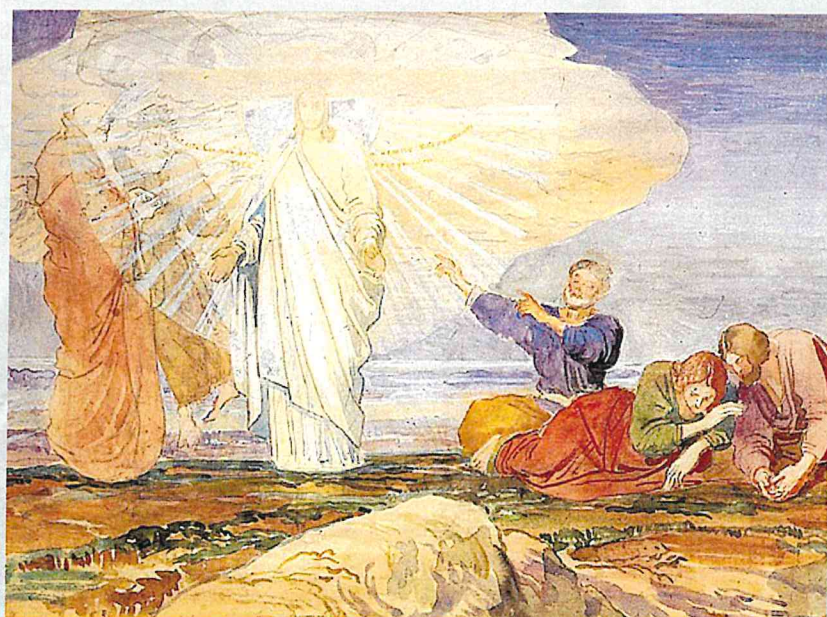

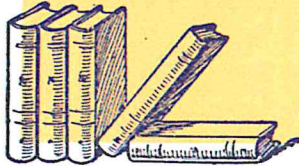

### "How much does it cost?"

Our Full Co-op Class Schedule:  
**Mondays, Wednesdays (+Catholic Enrichment Fridays) - \$2,150/child/yr**  
(includes \$300 worth of texts, supplies, curriculum + Lead-tutor)

### "Typical Day?"

We begin **Wednesdays** and **Fridays** with Mass, followed by community prayer, singing, and virtue discussion before class breakaway. The day can end at 12pm or 2:30pm based on the child/parent's discernment.  
**Fridays** are chock full of CGS, Liturgical living crafts, Saint of the Week, Science experiments, Drama & Choir!

### "I see you mention drop-off, what does that mean exactly?"

We recognize that part of being a homeschool co-op is pooling resources, time, and camaraderie to allow for new opportunities and sometimes a break in our homeschool week. Since we are a cooperative we ask that all involved parents attend and support the co-op and commit to being a TA/volunteer 2 days a month in support of our lead-tutors.

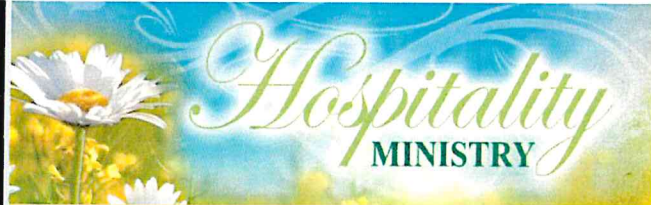

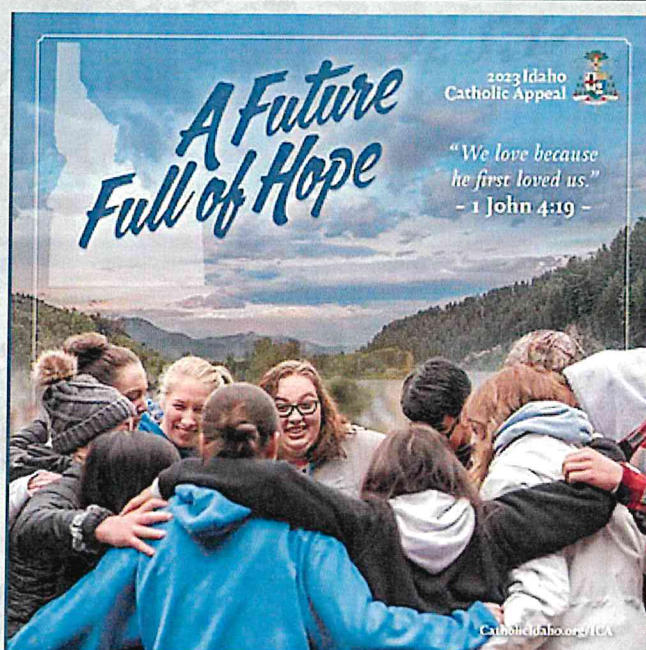
The mission of the Hospitality Committee Ministry is christian service through hospitality.
