

# From the Desk of Fr. Zach

Last weekend I wrote an article for the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, the Feast of Corpus Christi. After writing that article I felt impelled to continue that theme; thus this current article for this weekend is a continuation from my previous article. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes on many forms in our lives and within the Church. You have Eucharistic Adoration, where the Eucharist is placed in the monstrance and exposed for prayer. There are also Eucharistic processions, we are able to adore Christ through this procession. You have other forms of adoration. Every time you enter a church and come before the Blessed Sacrament in the Tabernacle you are to genuflect, offering adoration to Jesus Christ, the King of the Universe who is truly present in our midst. If you can't genuflect due to a health problem, then you are asked to make a profound bow towards the tabernacle. Another form of adoration is by praying in church, with the Blessed Sacrament in the Tabernacle. All of these, along with others, are ways in which we can adore Jesus present in

the Blessed Sacrament. Adoration is also shown in the way we receive communion. We *receive* communion: we never take communion. Even the priest receives the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ to nourish us in life, it is not for us to take. The church permits us to receive communion on the tongue or in our hand. Either way, we approach the Eucharist and bow slightly, acknowledging that this is truly Jesus Christ, we humble ourselves before the King. If we desire to receive on the tongue, then we approach with our hands folded and stick out our tongue for the distributer to place the Blessed Sacrament. If you desire to receive in the hand, then after your bow, you place your hand flat, less dominate hand on top of your dominate hand, as if you were making a throne for the King. You step to the side



and consume the Blessed Sacrament. The Eucharist is never to be carried in our hands, it is to be received and consumed within a few steps. If there is someone who cannot come up in line who desires to receive communion, let an usher know and they will tell the distributer.

It is a common practice to offer a prayer prior to receiving communion, asking the Lord to dwell within you, to help live your lives according to his plan. The same is true when we return to our pew after receiving communion. We should offer a prayer of thanksgiving, thanking the Lord for allowing us to receive him within us, nourishing us and keeping us from evil. We can continue this form of prayer even after we leave the walls of the church. We can always thank God for the blessings given to us in life, and ask for help in our struggles in life.



Another way in which we are able to adore, honor, and praise our Lord is by respecting the area in which he dwells. Have you ever noted how most churches are elevated, meaning you have to climb steps or go up a ramp in order to enter the nave, the body of the church? This is done for a reason. We are leaving the mundane, the worldly, and are ascending, elevating ourselves so as to partake in heavenly things. We are bridging the gap between earthly life and the divine so that "we may pass over to heavenly realities here foreshadowed." The nave of the Church, the area where the pews are, this is sacred space, it is the House of God. We are to adore and respect that space. We shouldn't fill it with earthly conversation but heavenly conversation, we call that prayer. When we elevate ourselves by ascending the stairs, we are entering a place fit for conversation with God. This time before and after Mass in the church should be devoted to improving our relationship with God. Even the Saints who were closely united with God emphasized how important prayer is for all of our lives, particularly surrounding Mass. It is through all of these various ways that we are able to adore, honor, praise and receive Jesus Christ, truly present in the Eucharist. 5


