Return of the "Salve"

It has been an entire year since we started singing the Marian Antiphons at Mass, and so now that we are back in "Ordinary Time," we switch our Marian Antiphon back to the *Salve Regina*. Over the past year, some parishioners have asked why we sing these Gregorian Chants and in Latin – didn't Vatican II do away with Gregorian Chant and Latin? The short answer is no.

The "Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy," which came out post-Vatican II (1964) states, "The church acknowledges Gregorian Chant as distinctive of the Roman liturgy; therefore, other things being equal, it should be given pride of place in liturgical services." (No. 116) The "General Instruction of the Roman Missal" (2002) further states, "All things being equal, Gregorian Chant holds pride of place because it is proper to the Roman Liturgy....it is fitting that they (communities) know how to sing together at least some parts of the Mass in Latin." (No. 41).



For a little review: The *Salve Regina* text is credited to Herimann Contractus, a monk of Reichenau (1013-1054), however, other scholars and historians credited it to Adhemar de Monteil (+1098) and St. Bernard (+1153). Of the four Marian Antiphons, this one is probably the most popular and familiar as it is said at the conclusion of the rosary; perhaps better known as the "Hail Holy Queen" (see the text below). This antiphon is sung from the day after Pentecost Sunday (or the day after the final day of the Octave of Pentecost) until the first Sunday of Advent. The Gregorian Chant *Ave Maria* may be substituted for the *Salve Regina*.

Salve, Regina, mater misericordiae; Vita, dulcedo et spes nostra, salve,

Ad te clamamus, exsules filii Evae. Ad te suspiramus, gementes et flentes In hac lacrimarum valle.

Eia ergo, advocata nostra, Illos tuos misericordes oculos Ad nos converte.

Et Iesum, benedictum fructum ventris tui Nobis post hoc exsilium ostende. O Clemens, o pia, o dulcis Virgo Maria. Hail, holy Queen, mother of mercy, Our life, our sweetness, and our hope.

To you do we cry, Poor banished children of Eve. To you do we send up our sighs Mourning and weeping in this vale of tears.

Turn then, most gracious advocate, Your eyes of mercy toward us,

And after this exile show us the blessed fruit of your womb, Jesus. O clement, o loving, o sweet Virgin Mary.


