An Encounter with God

The Value we Place on Mass and Reverence

“If we really understood Mass, we would die for joy.” -Saint John Vianney

Every so often, it's important to ask ourselves why we do (or don't do) something. Why do I go to Church? Why don't I go to Mass? I suppose there are ten-times as many answers to those questions as there are people to answer them. We all have our reasons.

It's more important to ask ourselves: *Why should I?* Answered well, that “should” can end up being a powerful motivator to move us toward what's really good for us.

Here, let me go back to our Eucharistic Revival theme—the true, the good and the beautiful. God desires only the best for us. If he didn't, would he have sent his Son to save us? Would he have given us all the blessings we have? And like parents who love their children, he doesn't always say ‘yes’ or allow things to be a walk-in-the-park; he permits us to struggle so that we'll grow strong. Sometimes it takes a lot of studying and thinking to understand the truth and why things are the way they are. The beautiful swan started out as an ugly duckling; and good of health is often only appreciated when we've experienced illness. So too, Mass can seem like one thing when it really is something far better. It might be a struggle to understand or make the effort, but it's well worth it!

If God only desires the best for us, then he wants to give us himself (he is *nothing less than the best!*). In choosing to give us himself—his own Body and Blood—in the Eucharist (which only happens at Mass), he must be saying that the Mass is really the most important time of our life. THAT MAKES TOTAL SENSE, because it's there that we have an immediate and intimate encounter with God. *Nowhere on earth does this happen except when we celebrate the Eucharist.* You can't get it in your living room or from a majestic mountaintop; it doesn't come at the seaside or from a quiet walk through the woods. They're nice, but they're not God. Heaven and earth only touch each other in the Eucharist. It's the way God has chosen to give us truth, goodness and beauty! If we really understood that... think how much we would value it; we'd die for joy! Nothing has greater value than the Mass. Nothing.

Have you ever been tempted not to go to Mass? The devil is the one who wants to do anything he can to keep you from what's good for you. He'll trick you in every way to get you to say no to God because he knows exactly how much God wants to give you at Mass. So... when you're particularly tempted not to go—realize that God must want to give you something really good, otherwise the devil wouldn't be working so hard to keep you from it!

Finally, once we know even a fraction of the value of the Mass and the real Eucharistic Presence of Jesus Christ in the church as found in the tabernacle and at Holy Communion, it changes the way we approach and worship him. If someone was willing to give you the best gift of your life, how would you behave? What would you wear to meet a famous person, how would act in the presence of the person you most admire? Would someone see us treat them differently or pay more attention to them than we do our Lord who is truly present in the church? Our reverence for God here (internally and externally) must match the value we place on what he's chosen to give us... himself.

NATIONAL Eucharistic Revival

The National Eucharistic Revival is a movement to restore understanding and devotion to this great mystery here in the United States by helping us renew our worship of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Here are a few ways we're introducing devotion in our parishes in the next month:

CATHOLIC 101 - ADORATION & TALK

As you may know, we have started **Catholic 101**, a revamped, weekly adult faith formation ministry that is open to both Catholics and those inquiring about Catholicism. Each evening will begin with 15 minutes of Adoration, followed by a topic to learn about the Catholic Faith. Our schedule for the next few weeks can be found under "Catholic 101" in the Parish News & Events section of the bulletin.

PRE-MASS WEEKEND ADORATION

On the first, third, and fifth (when applicable) weekends of the month, we will have 30 minutes of Adoration before each of the weekend Masses. Some of these weekends will be a **Guided Holy Half-Hour** to help you become comfortable with praying before the Exposed Blessed Sacrament.

Adoration Dates: Sept. 30-Oct. 1 (guided); Oct. 14-15; Oct. 28-29 (guided)

- **NOTE:** We will not have Adoration before the 9 AM Mass on Oct. 1 due to the prayer and blessing at the Police & Firefighter Memorials in Washington Park.

MONTHLY ADORATION WITH THE YOUTH

On the second Sunday of the month, all are welcome to come to Eucharistic Adoration with praise & worship music with the youth of our parishes. **Our first Youth Adoration will be held on Sunday, Oct. 8 from 6-7 P.M. at Holy Angels.**

ADORATION 101 - WEDNESDAY, OCT. 4

On **Wednesday, October 4 from 5:15-6 PM**, we will have 45 minutes of guided Adoration where you can learn how to pray a Holy Hour. More information will be provided in Fr. Hoyles' bulletin article next weekend (Oct. 1).

An Important Message from Father Hoyles & Fr. Zach

At certain points in their parish assignments, both pastors and associate pastors undergo a Ministry Review Process. This typically happens when a priest gets close to completing a term (typically six years for a pastor and 3-4 years for an associate). Father Hoyles has been pastor since July 2018 (5 years) and Father Zach arrived just over 3 years ago in July 2020. In the Diocese of Toledo, this process consists of a survey, which is sent electronically to a number of parishioners in order to gain vital feedback and insight, which will be used to help the Priests' personnel Board in making its recommendation to Bishop Thomas on term renewal or for a change in assignment. This survey also helps the priests to gain valuable, anonymous feedback on his strengths and areas for improvement.

In this process, approximately 75 people (per priest) will be asked to take a short survey, which will be sent via email to randomly selected parishioners in early October. The priests themselves also have the opportunity to select a few staff members and individuals who serve on various parish and school councils to take the survey.

If you are one of the families who receives a survey, we ask that you give each of the questions serious consideration and offer your best advice to the Personnel Board on our ministry and how it can be improved. We are tremendously grateful for your help in this important process!

Welcome, Father Prashanth!



Fr. Prashanth Kumar comes from Holy Rosary Parish in Shettihalli, Karnataka State; India. He was born on April 14, 1977. His parents Mrs. Rita and the late Mr. Anthappa, who passed away in February of this year, are devoted Catholics from the same parish. Father Prashanth has one older sister and 3 brothers (2 are older and 1 is younger).

In his younger years, Father Prashanth studied at his parish catholic school, St Mary's. After graduating high school in 1994, he went to seminary and completed his novitiate for the Pallottines in 1996. Following novitiate, Father studied philosophy, and theology, as well as spent a full year serving as a deacon. With great thanks to God, Father Prashanth was ordained a priest on April 21, 2007.

From ordination to 2013, Father Prashanth worked as associate pastor, and as an administrator in a seminary. He also served as a pastor in India during that time. In 2013, he began serving as an Associate Pastor in three parishes of the Archdiocese of Vancouver, Canada. Due to COVID restrictions, Father returned to India in 2020 and continued to serve there until coming to the United States in late August of this year.

Now in the USA, Father Prashanth is excited to begin his priestly ministry in a new place! In a recent email, he said: "I thank God for the gift of life and blessings, also thank the Almighty for the wonderful opportunities to serve HIM in different capacities."

Mike Claar and Donny Dix Move One Step Closer to Diaconate Ordination!



For the past four years, Holy Angels parishioners Mike Claar and Donny Dix have been involved in the Diocese of Toledo formation program for the Permanent Diaconate. In 2022 both declared their Candidacy to Holy Orders, the first major step toward ordination.

This weekend, at the 10:00 AM Mass at Rosary Cathedral in Toledo, Mike and Donny will be instituted into the Ministry of Lector. The Rite of Institution as Lector marks a significant step in the formation process and is a formal way to recognize one of a deacon's roles as Minister of the Word. The complete formation process will likely take an additional two years, concluding, by God's grace, with their ordination as Deacons in September 2025.
