## SCALABRINIAN FATHER JACQUES E. FABRE NAMED 14TH BISHOP OF CHARLESTON



Pope Francis has appointed an order priest born in Haiti as the new pastoral leader for the Diocese of Charleston. Bishop Robert E. Guglielmone introduced Father Jacques Fabre, CS, today as the 14th Bishop of Charleston. Bishop-elect Fabre is a member of the religious order the Missionaries of St. Charles (Scalabrinian Fathers). "I am humbled to be named Bishop of Charleston and look forward to serving the people of South Carolina," said Bishop-elect Fabre. "As shepherd, it is my hope to work together to strengthen our Church and project God's love to all who we encounter." Bishop-elect Fabre was born on Nov. 13, 1955, in Port-Au-Prince, Haiti. He immigrated to New York City while in high school and completed his secondary education. He joined the order of the Missionaries of St. Charles and took his first vows in 1982. Four years later, on Oct. 10, 1986, he was ordained to the priesthood in Brooklyn, NY. Over the past 35 years, Bishop-Fabre served in various locations and in a variety of roles. Since 2008, Bishop-elect Fabre has served as administrator of Mission San Felipe de Jesus in Forest Park, Ga. He speaks five languages including English, Spanish, Italian, French and Creole. Bishop-elect Fabre will succeed Most Rev. Robert E. Guglielmone, DD, who has served as the Bishop of Charleston since March 2009. "As Bishop of Charleston, it has been a pleasure to serve the faithful in South Carolina. Together, we have served the less fortunate, developed new programs, opened additional schools and outreach centers, and built new churches," said Bishop Guglielmone. "There is so much more to be done and I'm more than confident that Bishop-elect Fabre will serve our diocese well in the upcoming years." Bishop-elect Fabre will be installed as the 14th Bishop of Charleston on April 29.





## First Sunday of Lent



**IN THE DESERT.** Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, and then the devil tested him. Moses and the Israelites had been in the desert for forty years before being led to the land of milk and honey. There were times when they called out to God, sure that, as Saint Paul wrote to the Romans, "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." We sometimes spend time in the desert as well. Not a literal desert most of the time, but a desert in which it seems difficult to perceive God's presence, times when we face difficulty and are tempted to leave God's ways behind. ## COLUMN SUBMITTED BY STEWARDSHIP COUNCIL

*We hear a knock at the door. A homeless woman stands, asking how to sign up for the Clothing Closet. The Clothing Closet is open Tuesday mornings, this is Thursday. Sister gently tells the woman there is no need to sign up, just come on Tuesday mornings. By the way, you can probably get a sandwich, a bag of chips and a drink... The lady tells Sister that she is just looking for some shoes. What she has on her feet are thin-soled and light weight, not very warm in the winter weather. Sister brings her inside. Then the lady tells us she needs two pairs of pants, please. Her pants were stolen at the homeless shelter, and she only has what she has on. Sister nods and goes to get some sneakers, and see what pants she might have.*

Most homeless people walk 5 to 10 miles a day. If they find somewhere warm to sleep at night, they are shooed out in the morning with nowhere to go. So they walk and walk. Sneakers and shoes are badly needed. And there is a constant need for men's and women's underwear. In these days of Lent, can you give up a Starbuck's coffee, or maybe a fast food meal, and buy a package of underwear (large sizes, please, not white), or socks. Let's help out **Catholic Charities of the Midlands** with all the good work they do. Please. For Jesus... At the time of His resurrection...

And this from Deacon Ron Anderson (Ret.) Former Regional Coordinator of Catholic Charities of the Midlands:

*It was a day just like any other at Catholic Charities until I heard a knock on the door. On the other side of the door was a husband and wife. They had been living in their car, but after being car-jacked at a gas station, they were left with only the clothes they had on their backs. The husband requested a pair of pants and a dress shirt for a job interview the next day. He then, with a very timid voice, asked for a blouse for his wife. They were very happy to receive clean clothing. The next day, I received a phone call that he did get the job! Thank you to all who donate their gently used and new clothing to our clothing closet. You provided more than just clothing for this couple.*

**The Knights of Columbus are challenging all parishioners to give at least 40 cans or \$40 for the 2022 Lenten Season!!**

If every registered family (well over 800 families at Our Lady of the Lake) gives 40 cans during this Lenten season, OLL would collect well over 24,000 pounds of food for the We Care Food Pantry. Calculation: 40 cans (12 ounce cans) equals 30 pounds of food multiple by 800 families equals 24,000 pounds of food!

In the past few years since 2018, the Parish's Knights have collected around 3,500 to 4,000 pounds during the Lenten Season. This is short of the potential of 24,000 pounds that we could collect if every family donated just 40 cans or \$40 during Lent. This is a small Lenten sacrifice for the good of our community and the poor and needy of our local area.

I personally see the need every Wednesday at We Care with many of our own parishioners who volunteer their time at every week. There is so much need in our local community.
