
BISHOP-ELECT JACQUES E. FABRE, CS, WILL BE ORDAINED AND INSTALLED MAY 13 AT 2:00 P.M. THE CELEBRATION WILL BE HELD AT THE NORTH CHARLESTON CONVENTION CENTER, 5000 COLISEUM DRIVE IN NORTH CHARLESTON. HE WILL FORMALLY TAKE POSSESSION OF HIS EPISCOPAL SEAT AT MASS AT THE CATHEDRAL SUNDAY, MAY 15.

Pope Francis has appointed Father Jacques Fabre, CS, as the 14th Bishop of Charleston. Bishop-elect Fabre is a member of the religious order the Missionaries of St. Charles, or Scalabrinian Fathers.

"I am humbled to be named Bishop of Charleston and look forward to serving the people of South Carolina," said Bishop-elect Fabre. "As shepherd, it is my hope to work together to strengthen our Church and project God's love to all who we encounter."

Bishop-elect Fabre was born on Nov. 13, 1955, in Port-Au-Prince, Haiti. He immigrated to New York City and completed his secondary education. He joined the Scalabrinians and took first vows in 1982, and was ordained a priest Oct. 10, 1986. Over the past 35 years, Bishop-elect Fabre has served in many places — such as Cuba, Colombia, Rome and the Dominican Republic — and in a variety of roles. He was serving as administrator of Mission San Felipe de Jesus in Forest Park, Ga., when he received the call to become the Bishop of Charleston. He speaks five languages including English, Spanish, Italian, French and Creole.

God, eternal shepherd, you tend your Church in many ways and rule us with love. You have chosen your servant, Jacques, to be a shepherd of your flock. Give him a spirit of courage and right judgment, a spirit of knowledge and love. By governing with fidelity those entrusted to his care, may he build your Church as a sign of salvation for the world. Amen.









Third Sunday of Easter



GOD'S OVERFLOWING KINDNESS. The superabundance of God's kindness ties all of today's readings together. Especially when life overwhelms us, the Lord provides all we need, and then some. In the Acts of the Apostles, Peter takes the lead when facing the Sanhedrin. We might expect the man

who denied Jesus to crumble under the imposing glare of the high priest. Instead, the Holy Spirit helps him testify to his faith in Jesus Christ. What Peter had lacked before, courage and conviction, God provides in abundance. Similarly, today's Gospel shows Jesus providing a surplus of fish for the disciples. They have no luck fishing until the Lord intercedes. Jesus supplies an almost ridiculous number of fish, and he cooks it for them, too. As our reading from Revelation affirms, the overflowing riches of God require constant praise. Countless creatures—"everything in the universe"—cry out to honor the Lord, forever and ever.





Some months ago, OLL began a ministry called ‘Friendly Voices’ with the intent of calling every parishioner to check on their well-being and offer help or simply provide a friendly voice to talk to during the pandemic. The pandemic marked a lonely and isolating time and had a lasting impact on many lives. Most of our parishioners appreciated our efforts in reaching out and hearing that friendly voice. We made a concerted effort to reach all registered parishioners several times.

Parish Neighbors grew out of the Friendly Voice ministry with similar objectives, building faith-based relationships and supporting each other when there is a need.

The ministry lead, Kitty Kelly Wilson mapped all 940 parish families into neighborhood groups within a short drive from each other. Mapping is complete and there are 49 neighborhoods composed of 8 to 30 parishioner families, most within a five-minute drive from each other.

Now we are in the formation stage in bringing families in each neighborhood together to fulfill our objectives: building relationships, supporting each other, and growing and deepening our faith. We’ve made a terrific start. We thank the 26 volunteers that have stepped forward to be **Parish Neighborhood Contacts**, good stewards who take an active role in the neighborhood and who others in the neighborhood can depend on. But we need more! We have 22 neighborhoods that need one or more neighborhood contacts to bring this ministry to the entire parish community. 
