
Baptism ~ Baptisms scheduled in advance. Please call the Parish Office for more information or to attend a Baptismal Preparation Session.


- 1) Registration in the Parish for a sufficient period of time.

2nd Sunday of Easter (or Sunday of Divine Mercy)


