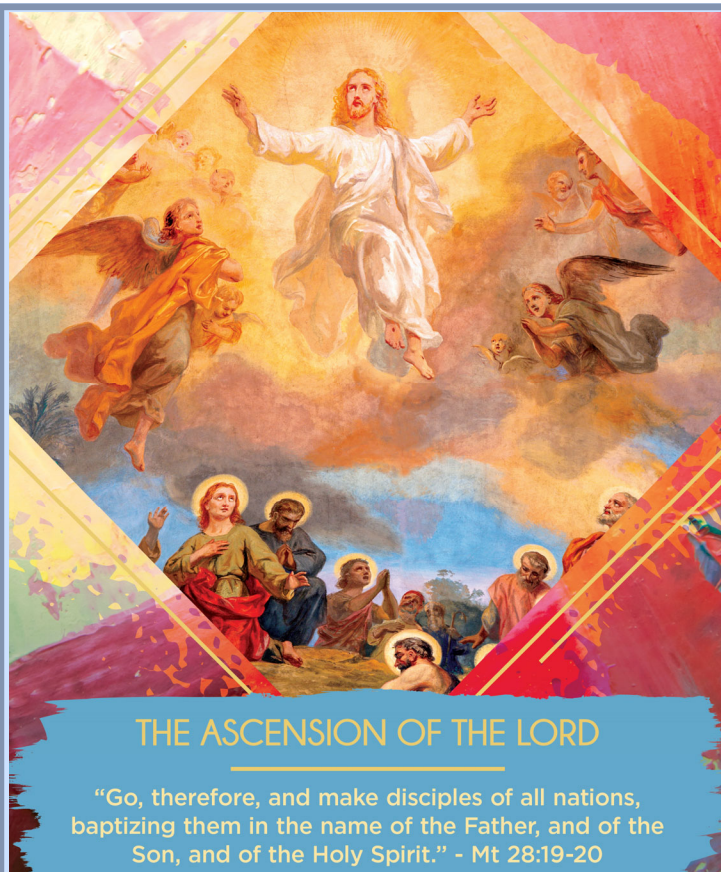
Baptism ~ Baptisms scheduled in advance. Please call the Parish Office for more information or to attend a Baptismal Preparation Session.

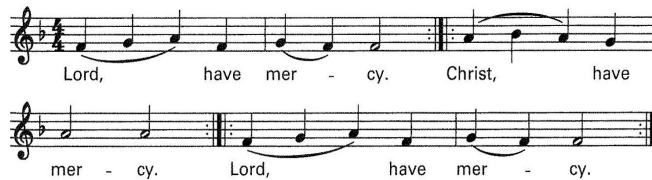

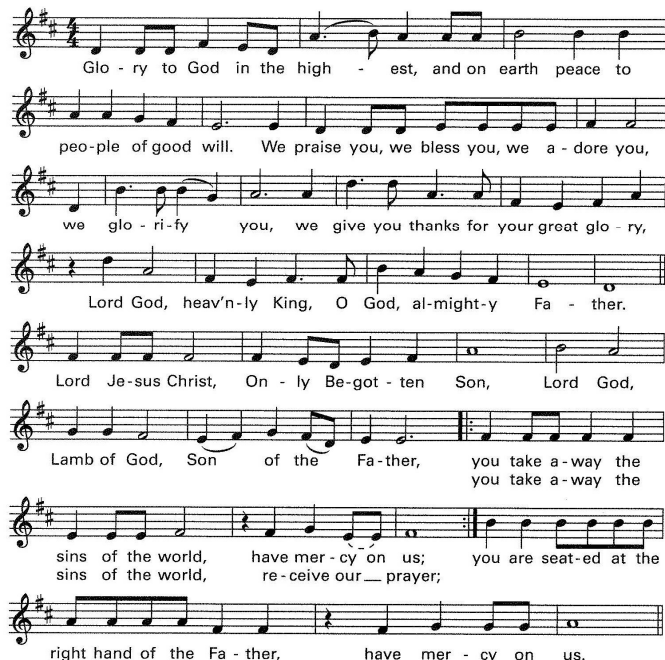

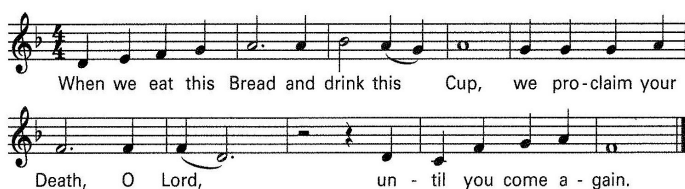

Chapin clinic is staffed entirely by volunteers: physicians, nurses, administrative staff, patient educators, and interpreters. We are in need of all levels of volunteers. *The clinic has an urgent need for providers: doctors, APRNs, PAs. Chapin Clinic is very flexible when it comes to scheduling. Providers arrive between 4:00 & 4:30 and generally serve 2-3 hours a clinic and can schedule to come as often as they wish. 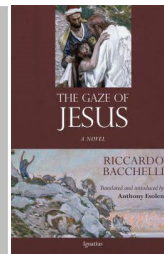
