**Fr. Tim's Tidbits**

Tuesday is All Saints Day, a holy day of obligation. More than an obligatory feast day, our pause each November 1st celebrates this wild, infectious, holy community of men and women in heaven; their unique personalities, abilities, character, language, and ethnicity radiates the promise of God's image and calling within each individual's earthly life. And their intercessory grace continues to guide us toward the light of eternal life, to one day join that great community of saints. Honoring this, our Catholic tradition, I leave you with the following thought on sainthood by Robert Ellsberg from his book, All Saints: Daily Reflections on Saints, and the words of several saints.

"What do they have in common? They did not apply themselves to being 'saints.' If anything, they applied themselves seriously to the task of being human, understanding this vocation in the profound sense reflected in the old formulas of the catechism: 'Who made you? God made me. Why did God make you? God made me to know, love, and serve him in this world and to be happy with in the next.'

No, the saints are not perfect humans. But in their own individual fashion they became authentic human beings, endowed with the capacity to awaken that vocation in others. . . .to call someone a saint means that his or her life should be taken with the utmost seriousness. It is a proof that the gospel can be lived."

"One life is all we have and we live it as we believe in living it. But to sacrifice what you are and to live without belief, that is a fate more terrible than dying." (St. Joan of Arc)

"We need to find God, and he cannot be found in noise and restlessness. God is the friend of silence. See how nature - trees, flowers, grass- grows in silence; see the stars, the moon and the sun, how they move in silence... We need silence to be able to touch souls" (Mother Teresa)
