We welcome Bishop John Keehner next week Sunday at the 8:30am Mass, St. Malachy, and the 10:00am Mass, Sacred Heart.

Depending on his schedule, Bishop Keehner enjoys celebrating the Eucharist within the parishes of the diocese, meeting the parishioners without any special pomp. Though his time is limited at each parish because of his schedule next Sunday, we welcome his presence at the other end of the Sioux City diocese. Because the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica falls on the 9th, it supplants the normal Sunday of Ordinary time readings and prayers. St. John Lateran Basilica in Rome is considered the mother church of all the Catholic churches in the Western world. Inscribed on the church facade are the Latin words"omnium urbis et orbisecclesiarum mater et caput,"meaning, "The mother and head of all the churches of the city and of the world." Significantly the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica is to encourage Catholics to keep strong ties to our past and to the universal Catholic Church. The building of St. John Lateran was a mark of religious freedom.

The church home of a diocesan bishop is the cathedral. Here the bishop is enthroned on the cathedra, or chair, the symbol of his teaching authority. Among his celebrations in the cathedral are ordinations to the diaconate and priesthood. Though St. Peter's Basilica is the most noted Catholic Church in the world, the official church of the Bishop of Rome—the Pope—is St. John Lateran. God Bless, Fr. Tim
