The Holy Father's Intentions:

Religious Sisters and Consecrated Women: We pray for religious sisters and consecrated women; thanking them for their mission and their courage; may they continue to find new responses to the challenges of our times.

Pope Francis has often spoken of "Accompaniment." This is something good to reflect and think about. As followers of Christ, we are called to accompany others to Christ, to make His message known and make disciples of all (Mt. 28:19). Unfortunately, the word "accompaniment" has been greatly misused or misunderstood. It is supposed to mean "walking and guiding someone to our Lord." However, in most cases that I have heard, it has come to mean that we should do whatever the person wants to do, to "go with the flow." This is very dangerous to the soul. When we simply try to accompany someone by doing what they want to do, we are basically letting the blind lead the blind. True accompaniment is like taking someone by the hand and saying "come and see." Pope Francis has used this word a lot, and like many others things that he has said, it gets completely taken out of context. We must be careful about falling into this trap. Remember, Satan is very smart and knows how to twist things so that we turn away from God. During this month of February, reflect on the true words of Jesus and bring yourself to him. The worst thing one can do to their soul is say "I will follow Jesus MY WAY!" That is not accompaniment, that is selfishness. That is the deadly sin of pride. That is Satan's trick. Jesus' way is "come and follow me."
