Easter is fast approaching. What do we celebrate at Easter? The beautiful mystery of the Resurrection of our Lord. I am one who fervently believes that if one wants to get the most out of the Easter celebration, one must also take part in the whole of Holy Week. The Resurrection makes sense when one goes through the whole of Holy Week: The triumphant entry into Jerusalem, the Institution of the Eucharist and Holy Orders at the Last Supper, the Passion and Death of our Lord. It all plays together and I hope many will make the effort to take part in all these. When it comes to the Resurrection, it is something that has seemed to be severely taken for granted, and is therefore something to spend time reflecting about. If we say that we believe in the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of our Lord, then do we act like it? Do we worship our Lord in a manner that is not just pleasing to Him, but also is fitting for what He did for us? Every time I look at the cross and remember the Resurrection, I remind myself "He did that for me, for all the faithful, for the whole of humanity. How do I respond?" Many have taken faith for granted today and think that it should be conformed to the world. The Church must change is what they say. I say NO! Rather, it is us who must change. Look at what God did for us. If we truly believe in that, how can (or how dare) we say that the Truth must change to our feelings. How dare we demand faith to change after our own desires. Jesus suffered death for us, he rose from the dead for us. He calls us to follow him. We must change ourselves to be able to do that. We will soon celebrate the Resurrection. How will you respond to our Lord?
