

A Message from Deacon Matthew Miller:

In the November edition of Archbishop Jackels' monthly bulletin insert, he discusses initial findings of the synod report on parish vitality. This report is focused on how to deal with the problem of not enough priests for the number of parishes. He reminds us that one of the three essential activities of a vital parish community is gathering for daily prayer. If parishes are not doing the three essential activities, it is likely that they will be considered for closure. As an alternative to closing parishes, the Archbishop is suggesting that deacons, sisters, or the laity take on additional roles of leadership and he gives "gathering in church on weekdays for prayer" as one of the examples.

The Liturgy of the Hours, or Divine Office, is like the Mass in that it is a public form of prayer. "It is an ancient, structured way of praying Scripture throughout the day, focusing especially on the Psalms." Deacon Matt will be leading the Liturgy of the Hours during our regularly scheduled daily Mass times during the month of January when Fr. Frantz is in Haiti. Hope to see you there.

Christ's name is chosen in heaven, and the Angel Gabriel announces it when he informs the Blessed Virgin of the incarnation: "Behold thou shalt conceive in thy womb and shalt bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name Jesus". It is a name that has marvelous implications, for it means "savior." The very name bespeaks the magnitude of His mission, His infinite love, a love that will cause Him to offer Himself up for us.
