Pope Francis has appointed Bishop Richard Pates, retired Bishop of Des Moines, to serve as Apostolic Administrator until the next Archbishop of Dubuque is named.

I've enjoyed getting to know you, praying with you, sharing meals together, joining you as a partner in ministry.

Your responses on our Synod Survey confirmed our ministry: sharing with the Church and the poor; learning/teaching the Gospel; devotion to and worship of the Eucharist. These are ministries that you rightly appreciate, are presently committed to, and want to see enhanced. Keep up the good work. You're great. God bless you. I'll miss you. Let us pray for each other, and keep our eyes fixed on Jesus.
