- Gather with the people of the archdiocese on Sunday, September 8 at 2 p.m. to celebrate the imposition of the pallium on Archbishop Zinkula by Christophe Cardinal Pierre, Apostolic Nuncio to the United States. The pallium is a vestment worn by a metropolitan archbishop that symbolizes his unity with the pope and role in shepherding his flock. Archbishop Zinkula received the pallium from Pope Francis in Rome on June 29 and this Mass allows us to celebrate him as our new shepherd as the Papal Nuncio imposes it on him. The Archdiocesan Pallium Mass will be held at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, located at 1350 Lyndhurst Drive, Hiawatha. Cardinal Pierre will give a presentation at 1:15 p.m. prior to the Mass about synodality and Eucharistic Revival. During the Mass, he will impose the pallium on Archbishop Zinkula, and deliver the homily. Archbishop Zinkula will preside at the Mass.
