The theme chosen by the Holy Father for 2024, “Do not cast me off in my old age” (cf. Psalm 71:9), wishes to call attention to the fact that, sadly, loneliness is the bitter lot in the lives of many elderly, so often the victims of the throw-away culture. He has invited everyone “to show our tender love for grandparents and the elderly members of our families.” **Call or Visit your Grandparents this week!**
