- Archbishop Zinkula has issued a statement in advance of the election about the vital role we play as citizens. To learn how Catholic Social Teaching should help us form our consciences and guide our vote in this important election read his statement below:
 - As Catholics, we are urged to act in accordance with our faith. This includes how we conduct ourselves in political activities and how we choose our elected officials. We have a right to let our voices be heard and a responsibility to vote and choose our elected officials. In doing so, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops encourages us to engage in "Faithful Citizenship," allowing our activities and decisions to be guided by our faith and moral convictions. Our national tradition provides us with the great benefit of religious liberty and encourages all people of faith to bring their beliefs and insights to the voting booth. As we make decisions about a political candidate or issues, we must use a well-formed conscience to help guide us. Here are some specific ideas to help form our conscience:
 - Begin by **being open to the truth** and what is right
 - **Study Sacred Scripture** and **teaching** of the Church
 - **Examine the facts and background information** about various choices and be discerning in where we gather information.
 - **Prayerfully reflect** to discern the will of God.
