 - **World Day of Prayer for Vocations** on Sunday, May 11. Pope Francis released his message for the 62nd World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Today the Church throughout the world prays for vocations. Pray for the priests who have ministered to you throughout your life, both living and dead. Encourage your children, grandchildren, or other young people to consider a vocation as a priest or religious brother or sister. Pray a rosary for more young men and women in our diocese to respond to God's call. As Catholics, we firmly believe that God has a plan for our lives! He calls some to marriage, some to the priesthood, and others to religious life or to live as generous single people. Fully living our own vocations—and teaching young people how to discern God's call—is a serious duty, but also a joyful one. During this week, please encourage the young people in your life to be open if God calls them to priesthood or religious life.
 - **Our Call to Share – Spring Collection.** In the coming few weeks, we will take up the *Our Call to Share* – Spring collection. This is a 4-in-1 collection that supports four important regional and national ministries. By giving to ministries beyond our local parish, we respond to Christ's call to be as one body – united in faith and mission - through our support of the broader Catholic Church. This spring's collection will benefit the following four ministries:
 - **The Catholic Campaign for Human Development** – A collection for the national anti-poverty program of the US Catholic Bishops, focused on empowering people to break the cycle of poverty.
 - **The Retirement Fund for Religious** – A collection to support congregations of religious sisters, brothers, and priests from across the United States who do not have adequate funding to support their members' retirement and healthcare costs.
 - **The Hispanic Ministry Collection** – A diocesan collection to specifically support Hispanic ministry at parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Dubuque.
 - **The Catholic Communications Campaign** – A collection to assist the Church spread the Gospel message through media and communication efforts at the local, regional, and national levels.
