FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

A Weekly Encounter with Christ

When I was in high school, I was attending the summer Steubenville Conferences put on by Franciscan University in Steubenville, OH. On Saturday night of the conference, there is a big, two hour adoration where Jesus, present in the Eucharist, processes around the arena.

As a sophomore in high school, I was seeing the priest take Jesus and offer personal encounters and moments with so many people around the arena. I wanted that. I wanted



Jesus to stop right in front of me for a personal encounter. So I schemed and arranged to be on an aisle seat so He could walk right by me. And he didn't. I didn't get that personal moment of blessing. I was so upset. I was a little dramatic in how upset I was and making a big show of it.

At the end of adoration, the emcee spoke of how powerful it is to encounter Jesus. He mentioned the beauty of Him coming to us and walking among us. Hearing that just made me more upset that I didn't get my personal one-on-one moment. Then he said something that blew my mind. He told us that we could have that moment every time we go to Mass.

He said that the same Jesus who was present in the arena that night is there for us every time we are at Mass. He is fully present to us in the Eucharist. It is the same Jesus that walked with the apostles and performed miracles of healing and raising the dead. The Jesus that ascended and sits at the right hand of God the Father in Heaven is at the same time fully present in the Eucharist. He even comes closer to us in the Eucharist than he was to the Apostles.

Jesus comes to us in the Eucharist and allows us to receive Him into ourselves so that we can be changed and healed by Him. In the same way that he healed the bleeding woman, he offers us healing. The same Jesus who was at work in the New Testament is still at work today. And we don't just get to see Him, we get to receive Him into our bodies. What a gift!

And guess what else? Jesus, who spent time with the Apostles and the crowds wants to spend time with you! If you want to grow in your relationship with Jesus, come spend time with Him! Eucharistic Adoration is available every day. Jesus is waiting for you to come see Him. Stop by and have your own personal encounter with the Lord.


Celebrating the Month of the Sacred Heart

June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion invites us to draw near to the tender, burning love of Christ. It's a perfect month to help us understand that Jesus' heart is full of mercy, compassion, and love for each of us.

The Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is celebrated on the Friday after the second Sunday after Pentecost. This year, it falls on Friday, June 27, 2025. It is a solemnity, meaning it's one of the highest feast days in the Church.

Grant them the wisdom, understanding, and strength they need to follow in the footsteps of Jesus.


Inspire them with the vision of your Kingdom.
