

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



Discipleship is Imitating Christ

Last week I began explaining DISCIPLESHIP from the perspective of Jesus' command to his disciples. But how does one become a disciple? For us Catholics, the sacraments are essential for discipleship. Baptism initiates one into discipleship, the Eucharist sustains it, and Reconciliation restores and strengthens it. This week I want to explain this concept further.

When we were baptized, we were inserted into the life of the Trinity, and thus claimed for God. We were enrolled in the number of those who have responded to the Lord's call to follow Him. We become his disciples. But this is only the beginning of a lifelong journey. Discipleship is a way of life. Jesus did not call us to follow him only for a year or a season, but for all of our lives. Our call to follow Jesus is not reserved for only the good and happy times, but even during the bad and sad times.

Discipleship is a lifelong process of learning and growing in the faith. A disciple always strives to learn how to think, speak, and act from her teacher. Our thought, speech and actions must be in keeping with the teaching of Jesus as revealed in Scripture and espoused by the teachings of the Church (Magisterium). To be a disciple of Jesus is to strive to live in the way Jesus lived: in humility, love, forgiveness and service. It is to live in total imitation of Christ.

A good place to start imitating Christ in our life would be living the Beatitudes (Matthew 5) and the corporal works of mercy. I will list the beatitudes next for your reflection. Take a moment to pray with these this week.

Blessed are the poor in spirit,
for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.
Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness,
for they will be filled.

Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.

Blessed are the peacemakers,

for they will be called children of God.

Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness,

for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me.

Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

Which of these beatitudes do you practice daily, and how do you do that? Which is difficult for you at the moment? I would like to hear from you.





Importance of Christian Burial

At a time of loss, we join together to call on the Lord. Above all, this is a time for prayer. In a funeral Mass, the entire Church in heaven and on earth, joins to sing God's praise and to pray for the gift of the Kingdom of Heaven. Jesus, who died and rose for us, offers himself in this great act of love, and offers us a resurrection.

Because of our belief not only in the immortality of the soul, but also in the resurrection of the body, the Church professes hope in the face of death, and acts with charity in the funeral rites. The Church provides a number of prayers for the faithful to offer both to accompany the dying of a loved one and to strengthen our faith upon their death. Through private prayer and public funeral rites, we strengthen our faith and hope, comfort those who mourn, and bury the bodily remains of the deceased with care befitting what was the Temple of the Holy Spirit.

In this time of mourning for loved ones, it can be challenging for the family to think through planning a funeral Mass. All Catholics are invited to have a Catholic funeral and we want to help you plan yours. It is a good practice to meditate on our death. It helps us evaluate how we are living and ensure that our lives will get us to Heaven. Planning your funeral can take the strain off them when the time comes.


