**PASTOR'S NOTES:** We read the gospel story of the Samaritan Woman at the well this weekend. It is an amazing story showing how far Jesus will to go to reach lost sheep. At that time there were many taboos which Jesus broke to reach her. Men were not to speak to the wives of other men, but especially a Rabbi should avoid this. Jews were not to drink the vessels of the aentiles or they would be considered unclean. Jews did not speak to Samaritans because they were enemies. In puzzlement she asked, "How can you, a Jew, ask me, a Samaritan woman, for a drink" (John 4:9b)? The other thing about this whole conversation was that she was separated from her own people because she was considered a woman of ill repute, after all she had five husbands and the man she was living with now was not her husband as Jesus pointed out. She would not have come out in the heat of the day if she could be with the other women of her religion. It is quite the testimony to Jesus' desire to reach someone. In the Preface for this weekend's Mass, the priest reads, "For when he asked the Samaritan woman for water to drink, he had already created the gift of faith within her and so ardently did he thirst for her faith, that he kindled in her the fire of divine love." Mother Theresa of Calcutta built much of her spirituality on how much Jesus' thirsts for our response to his loving out reach. In John 19:28b Jesus says from the cross, "I am thirsty." Jesus really is thirsty for a relationship with us and for us to respond, "to give him a drink". One way that I am aging to respond to Jesus this year is I am going to feed Jesus who is hungry in Haiti which is at all time high with 55% of the people at the near-starvation level. I love what Partners in Progress is doing to allow Haitians help Haitians in their Farmer to Farmer workshops. I am going to send a check with a few others who have already committed to Partners in Progress. Maybe you want to join me to respond to Jesus who is hungry and thirsty.
