PASTOR'S NOTES: "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me" (John 14:1, NABRE), so says the Lord to us his disciples. How often do we let our hearts be troubled? I would say that it is rare that our hearts are not troubled! Even if we have troubles, is it possible to avoid having "troubled hearts." I think it is possible if we are tapped into our source of our peace. Jesus. This morning I found out that a classmate from Major Seminary (Graduate School) that was ordained 35 years ago in 1988 asked the archbishop for retirement because of health issues. He was the second of the eleven of us that asked for retirement because of health issues. This reminded me that it is quite a regular occurrence that we let our hearts be troubled without even realizina it. Yesterdav I was textina four different groups at the same time as I tried to schedule a funeral and reschedule other aatherinas. I am inclined to the think that our technology has not decreased our stress, but actually increased our stress. Most of us priests try to take a day away on Monday, but usually when I am with my priest group on Monday, we are all responding to texts and taking calls, even when we are trying to have a quiet meal together. Someone recently referred to our mobile phones as our "mobile offices." I know priests are not the only ones that allow constant interruptions by these "electronic chains." I think of arandparents trying to get to the activities of their grandchildren. My own parents (born in 1919 & 1928) rarely made it to their own kids sporting events. That was for the kids to play. Such is the world we live in and the expectations with which we live. Can we not let our "hearts be troubled" in the environment that we live in? I do think it is a good thing both for heart and health to go off line sometimes. Jesus said, "I am the way and the truth and the life" (John 14:6a, NABRE). If that is the case, we have to tap into Jesus, the Way, find time to read and think about the Truth, to open ourselves to the Life that flows to us through the Sacraments. May God helps us to have peace in our troubled world. Fr. Tim
