PASTOR'S NOTES: Jesus said to his disciples: "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth" (John 14:15-17b). We are coming closer to Pentecost, May 28th, so we are hearing more about Jesus sending the Spirit upon us. This last Friday our children were confirmed two months after the first scheduled date. It is a good time of year to be confirmed since, even on Sundays, Jesus is talking about the coming of the Holy Spirit. It seems that one of the prerequisites for receiving the Holy Spirit is to love Jesus. In school we take classes that are prerequisites for something else. You had to know what was taught in a certain class before you could take the next class or the second class would not make any sense. It seems that we have to love Jesus before living in the Spirit makes any sense. The Act of Love was a prayer that we were given in religion when I was growing up. We did not memorize that, at least I did not, but we certainly memorized the Act of Contrition! After confessing our sins, the priest expected that we would be able to say that prayer. As I have gotten older, I have realized how important it is to express my love to God. We know we have to express our love for family and friends to keep it strong, but what about our love for God? After Peter's denial of Jesus three times during the passion of our Lord. Jesus comes to him at the sea shore when Peter had gone back to his old job of fishing for fish instead of men (see John 21). The encounter between Jesus and Peter has become more and more meaningful as time has gone on. A retreat that a bishop gave a number of years ago helped me think about this encounter in my own personal life. The bishop had composed his own prayer based on this encounter between Jesus and Peter. His expression of love of God moved my heart and since then I daily express my love in this fashion. Next week I will give you that prayer in words even though it changes each time I do it. Please pray for our children

that they will come to love Jesus more and more as they grow in living in the Holy Spirit. Fr. Tim
