PASTOR'S NOTES: I have heard people say that those who talk about the Trinity are not biblical. They will challenge us to find the word Trinity in the Bible which is their one and only source of truth. The problem with this thinking is that it is not BIBILICAL!!! We heard on Ascension Sunday from the end of Matthew. Jesus says, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold I am with you always, until the end of the age" (NABRE, Matt 28:19-20). St Paul mentions all three persons in the second reading for today: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you" (2 Cor 13:13). This ends St. Paul's second letter to the Corinthians. These people that deny the Trinity will say that neither one of the passages I point out have the doctrine of the Trinity in them. They will claim that the Church made it up. We say no to that and reaffirm that when Jesus left, he sent the Holy Spirit to us to reveal all truth. Listen to John's gospel, "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth; for he will not speak on his own, but will speak whatever he hears, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. He will alorify me, because he will take what is mine and declare it to you" (16:12-14). Even though the full doctrine of the Trinity is not in the Bible, the Lord sent his spirit to guide the church into all truth. That same Spirit had to even guide the church into declaring what books are accepted as inspired. It is clear that the seeds for the teaching of the doctrine of Trinity is in the Bible. What the Catholic church teaches about the Trinity is consistent with the bible, even though the end result is fuller. It is like the difference between the seed of the walnut tree and the tree itself, very different vet a natural result. Fr. Tim
