**PARYER BEFORE MASS:** Almighty eternal God, behold, I come to the Sacrament of your Only Begotten son, our Lord Jesus Christ, as one sick to the physician of life, as one unclean to the fountain of mercy, as one blind to the light of eternal brightness, as one poor and needy to the Lord of Heaven and Earth.

I ask therefore, for the abundance of your immense generosity, that you may graciously cure my sickness, wash away my defilement, give light to my blindness, enrich my poverty, clothe my nakedness, so that I may receive the bread of Angels, the King of kings and Lord of lords, with such reverence and humility, such contrition and devotion, such purity and faith, such purpose and intention as are conducive to the salvation of my soul. Grant, I pray, that I may receive not only the Sacrament of the Lord's Body and Blood, but also the reality and power of that Sacrament. O most gentle God, grant that I may so receive the Body of your Only Begotten Son our Lord Jesus Christ, which he took from the Virgin Mary, that I may be made worthy to be incorporated into his Mystical Body and to be counted among its members.

O most loving Father, grant that I may at last gaze forever upon the unveiled face of your beloved Son, whom I, proposes to receive now veiled under these species:

Who lives and reigns with you forever. Amen

**PASTOR'S NOTES:** "Even all the hairs of your head are counted" (Matt 10:30). Imagine someone caring about the hairs on your head! "Oh, it looks like two more fell out!" That is the way Jesus expresses God's care for his people. God cares about not only each one of us but every aspect of us. God cares that you are in bed instead of out enjoying the free movement of the healthy. Sometimes people wonder if anybody cares. Jesus assures us that God cares like nobody else. It reminds me of that Spiritual Song that goes something like, "Nobody knows the trouble I've seen, Nobody knows my sorrow... Oh nobody knows the trouble I've seen, Nobody knows but Jesus." The slaves used to sing spirituals all the time. It was a way of consoling each other in the sad lot that was theirs. We just celebrated on Monday the emancipation of enslaved African Americans. It is celebrated on the anniversary of the order by Major General Gordon Granger proclaiming Freedom for slaves in Texas on June 19<sup>th</sup>, 1865. Of course, there were many lynchings of blacks in the south for the smallest things for years after that. Even in the 1960's blacks could not drink from the same water fountain as a white person. We should never forget the reality of those days nor pretend they were not bad. In this world there have been many horrible things that have happened to whole groups of people, like Native Americans, the Jewish People... This has happened throughout the world for centuries and that fact does diminish the horrible reality for each group to whom it happens. Early Christians were persecuted relentlessly and Jesus is preparing his disciples for that reality, "And do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna" (Matt 10:28). People can treat you horribly but don't become like the ones doing evil or the Evil One has a hold of you and he will destroy your body and soul. As St. Paul says, "Do not be overcome by evil,

but overcome evil with good" (Romans 12:21, NRSV). Fr. Tim
