PASTOR'S NOTES: Jesus invites us into an intimate relationship with Himself & the Father: "No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son wishes to reveal him" (Matt 11:27b). It is clear from this passage that the way to the Father is through the Son. For this reason at Mass we always pray "through our Lord Jesus Christ." All the Collect prayers, three per Mass, (Opening Prayer, Prayer Over the Gifts, Prayer after communion), begin the closing part with "through our Lord Jesus Christ..." Pray this Sunday's Opening Prayer: "O God, who in the abasement of your Son have raised up a fallen world, fill your faithful with holy joy, for on those you have rescued from slavery to sin you bestow eternal gladness. (We ask this) through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever." God in Jesus came right down into the basement where we were! He lowered himself for us who were part of this fallen, sinful world. The fact, that God came down in Jesus and loved us while we were yet sinners, gives us hope and with hope comes holy joy! He has rescued us from slavery to sin so we can have eternal gladness. We hear this week how we can find this eternal gladness: go to Jesus! "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me for I am meek and humble of heart: and you will find rest for yourselves" (11:29). The twist in this invitation is that the "Yoke is easy" and the "burden is light." It almost seems contradictory. Yokes are for work. Oxen were yoked together. But if the yoke fits you, it does not cut and if the work is appropriate to your strength and ability you can actually find joy in your work, you can find a sense that *you were made for this*. Jesus who is one with the Father and the Holy Spirit is the Creator, the Redeemer, and the One Who Sanctifies. And this amazing God through Jesus is inviting you to discover

through him what *you were made for* in order to find eternal gladness. Fr. Tim
